

KCYHA Coaching Information For 2020-2021

Coaches To-Do List:

1. **Register online with USA Hockey** as a coach at www.usahockeyregistration.com the cost is \$56.00. This needs to be done annually every August. This registration is also good for adult league. Click that your playing in the State of Kansas, Midwest Amateur Hockey Association (not Missouri Hockey) even if you live in the State of Missouri.
2. **Submit USA Hockey Membership # to KCYHA** using the following link. Make sure you indicate which club you are coaching for.

3. **Background Screen:** Background screen is good for two years. We will let you know if you need to submit screen. Please wait for communication from us before you complete the background screen with USAH, otherwise you may be charged \$30.
4. **Online SafeSport Training:** Must be completed every season before you coach. If you've completed the SafeSport Core module before, then you only need to take the refresher which is about 30 minutes long. If you are new to coaching, you must complete the Core module which takes about 90 minutes to complete and must be completed prior to coaching on-ice or off-ice.

5. **Complete Age Specific Module** online for the division you are coaching at. If you already have the module for the age division you are coaching you do not need to repeat it. <https://www.usahockey.com/agespecificmodules>
6. **Coaching Clinic – Level 1, 2, 3, 4.** All coaches must have current CEP certification by December 31st each season. New coaches start with Level 1 and advance one level each year unless you are coaching U8 in which you can stay Level 1 until you advance to Squirrels. At this time we do not anticipate having any local clinics due to COVID-19. **HOWEVER, NEW THIS SEASON** – You can take a Virtual Clinic online (\$50), or you can apply for a Temporary Card (\$50).
