Holiday Party Kick-Off Dinner





Skier Fitness

Proper balance will enable a skier to ski longer with less effort. You can make balance a part of your conditioning program in several ways. Activities like ice skating, and rollerblading enable you to practice changing edges with balance. Other activities that are recommended involve quick movement in six directions, left, right, forward, backward, up and down. These include sports like basketball, tennis and racquetball.

Training for balance should include exercises stationary and in motion. For stationary exercises try simple exercises like standing on one foot for ten seconds and progressively increasing. For more challenge close one or both eyes. Another exercise is holding a dumbbell in your right hand and with your feet spread out shoulder distance lift your right foot straight back trying to bring your leg parallel to the floor. Then slowly touch the dumbbell to your left foot. Do ten repetitions then use your left hand.

In motion exercises are important because you are training

your body to keep your center of gravity within the changing foot stance or base. If your center of gravity is outside of the stance then you involuntarily step to avoid falling rather than moving in the intended direction. After the involuntary step you are out of position to make the next desired movement. Think of the gymnast that needs to dismount and stick a landing. If the landing is not balanced then they need to make a stutter step to avoid falling. Doing squats on one leg is a good exercise to practice. Another is to walk on a narrow straight line. Jumping exercises can be in a variety of forms like jumping rope. Try forward and backward and side to side, then on one leg. This is excellent training for balance. Another exercise is to jump on one leg forward, then back to the center, then to the left and back, then backward, then to the right and repeat.

Good balance will provide you the ability to keep moving in the intended direction over changing conditions like bumps. The ability to complete a turn on the slopes and be in position to begin another turn is practiced in the gym with balance exercises.

Grand Canyon Raft Trip

Sixteen white water river people, including five BBSC members (Richard Porter, Toi Williamson, Karl Klokke, Donna Hiller, Dennis Swift) and their friends, just returned from a 21-day private rafting trip down the Colorado River of the Grand Canyon.

Karl Klokke was the permit leader who organized and put the trip together. First though, he had to go through the National Park Service permit process of waiting ten years for his permit to become available. Trip participants all agree it was well worth the wait. It was the trip of a lifetime for most of us. The October/November weather was beautiful, the canyon scenery spectacular, and the people were fun as well as very skilled and experienced boaters, with most (and all BBSC members) rowing their own boats.
