PARENT AGREEMENT



1. Only positive and encouraging comments will be directed towards your daughter, teammates, opposing players, parents, coaches or officials during practices and/or games. If a parent, grandparent, relative or friend of a WL player makes negative comments or projects negative body language during a game, they **will be asked to leave**.
2. Provide transportation to allow your daughter to arrive early to practice and to arrive early to play all scrimmages and tournaments, including out-of-town tournaments.
3. Provide adequate food and drinks for your daughter before, between, and after games and practices.
4. Parents make their best effort not to plan vacations or family events that conflict with practices or tournaments during the spring/summer season.
5. All family members refrain from "Coaching" your daughter during games, practices and scrimmages.
6. Remain out of the dugout and off the field at all times. The only exceptions will be if your daughter is injured or a coach requests a parent's attendance in the dugout or on the field.
7. Any discussion regarding player position or playing time should be discussed in private only with coaches. No such discussions will take place during games, team meetings or practices. Any concerns should be discussed with the coaches as soon as it develops. Your player should be encouraged to advocate for themselves and discuss concerns directly with their coach prior to any parent involvement.
Coaches will play your daughters at a position where they believe she can succeed individually, and will help the team to succeed as well. Tournament level play is competitive. Therefore, players may not get equal playing time. **Any questions, comments or concerns should be discussed in a private setting with coaches and should be scheduled at least 24 hours after the issue surfaces when possible.**
8. Support the decisions of the coaches 100%. If you don't agree with something, see #7 above.
9. Monitor and respond to emails and texts in a timely manner.
10. Read and review the "Player Agreement" and help ensure your daughter abides by that agreement.
11. Most importantly, provide your daughter with a positive and supportive environment when the game is over, whether the team wins or loses, and no matter how she performs. Always be a role model for your daughter in good sportsmanship.
12. Ensure your child, family, and any other spectators that are invited to the tournament, games and/or practices abide by the rules set forth by the Covid regulations and any other rules set forth by tournaments. We take this seriously and cooperation by all parties is mandatory. Failure to do so can result in asking for your daughter and family to leave immediately for the safety of others.
