Manager Duties and Responsibilities

Umpire Duties

- As part of your managerial duties, you will be assigned umpiring duty in divisions other than the one you are managing in (with the exception of the minor softball which is an instructional division only). You are responsible for providing two umpires to each game you have been assigned, one plate and one base. This may be you or a qualified representative, however, the manager is ultimately responsible for the umpiring duty. If you choose to use a Junior Umpire, you must provide an adult to supervise. This adult must remain on the field for the entire duration of the game. A Junior Umpire needs to be at least two years older than the oldest player in the division they are umpiring for.
- TLL will hold a yearly umpire clinic that covers the rules and mechanics of umpiring. This is a one day clinic that you or one of your coaches are obligated to attend. If you are unable to attend please notify the leagues Chief Umpire who will be attending in your place.

Snack Bar

- All teams will be given assigned days to cover the snack bar. Your team will be scheduled for snack bar duty up to 4 times in a season. It is your responsibility to make sure that your team has 4 volunteers (3 volunteers for the main snack bar, 1 volunteer for the small snack bar) covering your scheduled time slot. **No child under the age of 14 is allowed in the snack bar at any time!**

Work Days

- Managers are required to attend or provide a representative at all field work days

Field Prep/Clean Up

- Home team will water, drag and prep the pitching mound. Visiting team will paint the batters' box and foul lines before each game.
- Managers are responsible for the field prep before your game. Some teams get stuck prepping before and after, and that's not fair. This can be completed by yourself or other volunteers, but the manager is ultimately responsible. All fields should be dragged after the last game of the day.
- Each team will be responsible to clean their own dugouts at the conclusion of the game and provide at least one volunteer to return all league equipment (i.e. bases, pitching machines, etc.) to their proper locations.
- The visiting team playing on Uli Field and Read Field are responsible for taking down the field flag and returning it to the snack bar after the last game of the day.

If a manager does not follow through with their responsibilities the consequences will be as follows:

- 1ST Offense:** VERBAL WARNING
2ND Offense: ONE GAME SUSPENSION
3RD Offense: THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS WILL MEET TO DISCUSS APPROPRIATE ACTION

All Managers must follow the TLL Code of Conduct. Misconduct of any kind or violations may result in the manager being brought before the TLL Board and disciplinary action taken.
