It is with great regret and sadness, that I must announce that due to the Covid-19 pandemic, your board of directors has decided that we will not complete our spring season. We believe that this decision is in the best interest of the health and safety all players and their families, and in line with the current county guidelines. We did not come to this decision lightly and there were many factors that contributed to this conclusion. We all miss our baseball and softball teams.

With the timing of the pandemic occurring after our season started, RBY was placed in a financial predicament that nobody could have foreseen. We already invested a large percentage of our operating budget towards a number of costs that we typically incur with the beginning of a season e.g. jerseys, insurance, facility and field improvements, snack bar, etc. We cannot secure refunds from these investments, and in turn, we cannot in good financial conscience issue refunds to families for the incomplete season. RBY is a non-profit organization, and the monies we currently have as reserves will help us survive this pandemic, and preserve youth baseball and softball in Redlands for the upcoming seasons. If RBY was forced to issue refunds to the entire league, we would not have enough money to maintain our beloved league in 2021.

While maintaining social distancing, we will coordinate with managers to make a time for them to turn in their assigned gear and pick up their team's picture order. If your team has any outstanding candy money, you will be able to turn it in during this time.
