



We have moved into Phase 4 guidelines for Restore Illinois. This change will allow us to host games at both rinks. While in Phase 4 there are still capacity limits that we must follow. Below are a list of rules that will apply at both RMPD rinks. If at any time the park district observes spectators not following these rules they will be asked to leave the building.

Phase 4 West Meadows and Sports Complex Rules

Facility:

- All players, coaches, parents and staff must self-check for any COVID-19 symptoms prior to arriving at the buildings. If not feeling well, please stay home.
- All players, coaches, parents and staff must wear a face covering, over nose and mouth, at all times in the building. This includes locker rooms, entry and exit of building.
- Social distancing of at least 6-feet should be followed at all times.

Teams:

- Coaches and scorekeepers must wear a face covering, over nose and mouth, at all times.
- No out of state teams allowed.
- Maximum of 2 people in scoreboard. (Not 2 from each team)
- No team staff allowed in penalty boxes.
- A maximum of 3 rostered coaches on the bench is allowed.
- No pre-game warm-ups allowed in the building.
- Teams have access to locker rooms 12 minutes prior to ice time.
- No ice makes between periods.
- Teams must leave locker rooms and rink 12 minutes after game ends.
- Teams and coaches must remain in locker rooms before games (no wandering rink or watching previous game).
- Once in the building, you are in. There is no in and out of the building.

Parents:

- All parents must wear a face covering, over nose and mouth, at all times.
- All spectators must be seated in the bleachers and maintain 6-feet of social distance.
- Only 1 parent allowed in rink.
- Siblings are not allowed.
- Parents may enter the building at game time, no earlier.
- Parents must leave the building at end of the game. No waiting in the lobby for players.
- No loitering in lobby or bleachers.
- Top of West Meadows bleachers are off limits to parents.
- Locker room walk-way and stairs at Sports Complex are off limits to parents.
- Standing along the glass at either rink is prohibited.
- No food or drink allowed in rink or bleachers (including water and coffee).
- Each team is responsible for their own parents.
- West Meadows will have designated sections "A" and "B" parents will be limited to. Check the locker room board for the sections to sit in. This will allow for easier cleaning of bleachers
- West Meadows entry is through the automatic doors, while exit of the building is through the manual doors (on the right).
- Suburban Cook County travel ban is still to be followed.
- For practices we ask all parents to continue to stay out of the buildings.
- Live Barn is now active.

Anyone found to not be following these rules will be asked to leave the building.
