



LONDON - ST. THOMAS CROATIA SOCCER CLUB

Club Affiliation Policy

The London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club shall be a member of the Elgin Middlesex Soccer Association (EMSA) and its governing bodies: the Ontario Soccer Association (OSA), the Canadian Soccer Association (CSA) and F.I.F.A. and shall ensure compliance with all rules, policies and procedures established by these associations.

The President or designate and accredited representatives shall be the chief delegate at all regional meetings. The President may also attend meetings outside the Elgin Middlesex Soccer Association.

The London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club Board of Directors must give approval to the content of proposed Elgin Middlesex Soccer Association resolutions. All resolutions shall be forwarded to the Secretary of the London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club.

The London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club may propose candidates for district office and may submit resolutions to the Elgin Middlesex Soccer Association. The London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club's votes shall be cast in accordance with the direction given by the Board of Directors of the Club.

Any member of the London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club may propose candidates for district office. The London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club's Board of Directors shall approve any nomination before it is submitted to the Elgin Middlesex Soccer Association. Submissions to the EMSA must be received 30 days prior to their AGM.

Members of the club wishing to become a candidate for District Office must declare their intentions to do so at a meeting of the London – St. Thomas Croatia Soccer Club Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall approve only candidates for District Office who meet the requirements for District Office as set out in the EMSA Constitution.
