

How can I get the app and, more importantly, be tied to my player if I am not the parent who registered?

Each parent can use their team app on League Apps Play to keep track of their schedule and roster, chat with coaches and other team members, and see their team's standings. 1st-4th Grade Coaches are welcome to enter their team's practices into the schedule, so all team events will be in one location.

What should you do if you or your spouse is not getting emails or cannot access your schedule and roster on the app?

The parent that registered needs to log into their League Apps account in the top right-hand corner at this link: <https://deuceslax.leagueapps.com/dashboard>

After logging in and on your dashboard, you will see a link that says "Invite Parent/Guardian" (see screenshot below). Fill out the information, and the system will send a link to your spouse.

Your spouse will need to click on the link and create their account using the same email address as the one you were invited with. Once this has been done, they will begin to get emails. They also will need to download the app and log in with those same credentials to be able to see their player/team/roster and schedule on the app.
