

ONE GOAL PROGRAM



A **FREE**, fun, and easy way to try youth hockey before the season starts!

Purpose: Designed for first-year skaters at the Mite level (grades K-3), the One Goal program is a chance to learn and experience the game of hockey in a fun environment without committing to a full season of hockey.

Eligibility: Players must be at least 4 years old by the start of the One Goal Program to participate. Skaters should be first-year players at the Mite level (age 4-grade 3). One parent per child will be allowed in the rink. Masks will be required for all parents and for children when not on the ice.

Schedule: Sessions will be held on Saturdays: September 26, October 3, 10, 17 and 24. The final session will be held the day prior to the start of the Mite season (Sunday, October 25). Sessions will occur from noon-1pm.

Location: Burich Arena East, Hutchinson

Cost: FREE!

Each One Goal skater receives:

- Five, on-ice sessions with HHA coaches
- Free* use of the following equipment through the One Goal program and through the full hockey season, if desired:
