

Dear Parents,

We are excited to offer to our IFC Parents a GOAL-A-THON fundraiser to help with their Club Dues for the 2022-23 Season. You will be able to reach out to friends and family by email, Facebook, and Twitter, instead of going door-to-door, tracking commitments, and handling checks.

How It Works:

Make a pledge for every Goal scored by your player and raise money to help that family cover their IFC Dues for the 2022-2023 Season. Our Goal-A-Thon will be based on a club wide soccer event where players will receive 30 soccer balls and have the opportunity to shoot and make up to 30 goals.

Two Ways to Make a Pledge:

1. **FLAT DONATION** - You can sponsor your player with a flat amount.
2. **PLEDGE PER GOAL** - You can pledge an amount for Goals scored on the Day of the Goal-A-Thon. For example, each player gets 30 balls and each Goal they score is \$1. If you sponsored a student for \$1, you would owe \$1 * 30 Goals= \$30.

Your Player's Pledge Page:

You will receive an email with a link to your participant's pledge page. You do not need to login or change anything. Simply make a donation for whatever you can and share your participant's link with friends and family. No amount is too small.

What is a Goal-a-thon? The Goal-a-thon is our Clubs fundraiser in which IFC families, friends, and neighbors pledge money to support their player as they participate in the Goal-a-thon. Each Goal scored on the day of the Goal-A-Thon during a set time period will be tallied up and that will be their Goal number.

Why are we having a Goal-a-thon? We understand that competitive level soccer comes with a cost, and we would like to lessen these costs for each family. Each player could raise enough to have little to no fees this season. ALL of the money raised will go directly into the Players account to cover their dues (minus the 5-8% that the website, 99pledges, charges as their fee).

When is the Goal-a-thon? The Goal-a-thon will be held June 18 at F5 Futsal Facility beginning at 9:00am (players will receive a scheduled time to attend).

It is always asked, "I only received flat donations, do I need to attend?"—that is completely up to the participant. If you do fundraise and are unable to attend the actual Goal-a-thon, we will make sure that anyone who raised pledges/donations will get credit for participation.
