Purpose:

The purpose of the POP Whalen Wall of Fame is to commemorate the achievements of players who have distinguished themselves through excellence in hockey performance and/or service to BBH and/or other local associations.

The Nomination/Selection Committee:

Nomination guidelines for players being nominated:

Nominees must be out of active hockey playing (this excludes recreational hockey) for at least 5 years prior to being considered.

Player ability:

We desire to recognize a high level of player ability and achievement, and this can include:

- Participation and excellence locally (at the Pop Whalen Ice and Arts Center)
- Participation in and excellence at the college level, and/or
- Participation in and excellence at a high level of Junior Hockey play, and/or
- Professional participation and success, and/or
- Other

Player character:

We desire to recognize players that stand out in terms of their character including, but not limited to:

- Leadership
- Integrity
- Contribution to hockey

Nomination process:

The Selection Committee will consider nominations from any source as long as all of the information below is provided:

- Nominator's contact information (name, mailing address, phone number, and relationship to the nominee)
- Nominee's contact information (name, mailing address, email address, birth date, and phone number)
- Nomination letter (a brief summary and rationale for the nomination)
- Names of 3 references who played/worked directly with the nominee.
- Other supporting information that speaks to the candidacy of the nominee

Nomination packets should be mailed to Back Bay Hockey, Wall of Fame Committee, PO Box 1577, Wolfeboro, NH 03894. Nomination deadline is 12/31/24.

The committee will invite nominees to attend the recognition event to be held on March 22, 2024 at the Pop Whalen ice and Arts Center in Wolfeboro, NH.

Nominations not elected, in a given year, will be carried over and reviewed for the next 2 years for potential recognition at a later date.
