



MILFORD ICE ARENA COVID19 PANDEMIC RE-OPENING PROTOCOL

These guidelines will continue to be updated as new information becomes available and the facility can safely operate in the changing environment. Please visit the Milfordice.com website for updates to current policies. These policies are updated for 9/14/20 going forward. Please note that the safety of our customers & rink staff is of our utmost importance. Even though other facilities may not be, we are following the Governor's order.

Skater/Player/Coach/Parent/Guardian regulations and rules:

- If anyone entering the building feels any symptom of illness, the flu or has a fever, they should not come to the facility.
- Our waiver (available at milfordice.com and posted throughout the facility) applies to everyone entering the rink including Skaters, Players, Coaches, Parents and Guardians.
- Temperatures will be checked each time someone enters the arena. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4° will not be allowed into the rink.
- Everyone **MUST** wear a mask or gaiter when entering, exiting & throughout the facility. When on the ice & hockey helmets are on, a mask need not be worn but everyone must social distance as best as possible. Skating and hockey coaches must wear a mask when on the ice or bench.
- Anyone who visited another state in the last 14 days should disclose that information to the front desk.
- Once on the ice, hockey coaches & players cannot remove their helmets.
- For all rink programming, every participant **MUST** be pre-registered.
- No spitting on the ice.
- No high fives, handshakes, hugs, etc.
- No horseplay or refusal to follow these rules

Rink regulations:

- Hand sanitizer dispensers are available at the main rink entrance point.
- The locker rooms are open for games only and social distancing must be observed.
- Showers will not be accessible.
- The bathrooms are open.
- For games only, one parent/guardian per each athlete will be allowed in the building (parent must sign a waiver).
- LIVE BARN will be turned on for all games.
- Our snack bar & water fountain are not be operational; however, the Gatorade/Water and snack vending machine will be available. Cost for the drinks



are \$3.00 and the machine takes one-dollar bills and quarters. The snack machine accepts money and Apple Pay.

Session day procedures:

- We will be using the main entrance for entering & exiting the facility practicing social distancing directives.
- Sessions will be limited to no more than a combination of 50 players, skaters &/or coaches plus one parent/guardian per athlete. Games are limited to two competing teams, officials plus one parent/guardian per athlete.
- The rink doors will be locked until 20 minutes before your session or game. Players and skaters should wait until our rink staff opens the doors & then proceed inside practicing social distancing as they wait to be admitted. Parents will not be allowed in until the session/game starts and the previous parents have exited the building. The doors will then be locked once the session starts and parents/guardians cannot leave and re-enter the building.
- One person at a time will have their temperature taken so please have your Covid19 mask on. When complete, the next person will be checked.
- As customers enter, they will be positioned down the corridor with 6 feet of separation between them. There will be markings on the floor where the players should stand.
- Anyone who visited another state in the last 14 days should disclose that information to the front desk.
- When a skater's session has ended, the coach will send one person at a time to the rink door. All other players on the ice will remain maintaining social distancing & in full gear until directed by the on-ice coach to vacate the rink area.
- Once the session ends, all participants should exit the facility immediately. Players should not take their helmet off until they can put a mask on or leave the facility.
- Once outside, customers should proceed immediately to their car. No loitering outside the facility door or in the parking lot.
- Coaches will be responsible for maintaining social distancing of 6 feet when players are on & off the ice & when entering & leaving the ice.
- Our pro shop is open to sell water bottles, skate guards, mouth guards, etc. & for skate sharpening.

Anyone violating these rules will be removed from the facility.



Cleaning and Disinfecting:

- The facility will be cleaned and disinfected in accordance with CDC guidelines.
- All high touch areas will be disinfected every day.
- Adequate amounts of soap and hand sanitizer will be available for customers and employees.
- Employees:
 - Employees will be instructed to stay home if not feeling well.
 - All employees will wear proper PPE.
 - Employees will receive COVID awareness training to protect themselves and our customers.
 - Temperature readings will be taken daily of all employees.
 - Employees will regularly wash their hands or use the hand sanitizers.

Signage: Appropriate policies and guidelines will be posted at the front entrance and inside the facility. This protocol will be posted on our web site as well.
