Before you begin, ensure you [download or bookmark the Small Sided Laws of the Game](#). Reviewing the Law book prior to starting the modules will be beneficial

Modules may contain videos. You can pause the module and review the video(s) as many times as you wish.

Knowledge checks will take place at the completion of the module to ensure you have understood the information provided to you. You must score 100% in order to move to the next module. You will have multiple attempts.

Once you have passed the module, the correct and incorrect answers will be displayed on the screen. Take time to review your incorrect answers.

You do not have to complete all the modules in one sitting, however you must complete any module that you start. If you do not, you will have to repeat the unfinished module from the beginning of that module.


