

Taylor High School Athletic Booster Club Board General Meeting Minutes from September 12, 2022

President Brad Ingram called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m. from the THS 9th Grade Cafeteria. Secretary Shelley Eastland was present to record the minutes. There were 23 members present, including six parents, nine coaches and eight officers. Copies of the August meeting minutes were approved and are available on the website, along with the latest financial report.

Officer Reports:

Treasurer: Michael reported financials for the month of August with income of \$21,314.36 and expenses of \$8,090.39 for an overall total of \$13,223.97. Tax return should be back this Friday.

VP Membership: Brad, reporting for Keith, stated around 130 members at this point in the year with only 70 more to hit our goal! Over 30 of Mustang-level or higher were sold. The first time we have ever sold out of District passes and requested another 50 passes.

VP Fundraising: Spirit Night tonight at Layne's Chicken Fingers - must mention THS; next spirit night will be at Red River BBQ Sept. 20 must mention THS; Spirit Night at Cook Shack is in the works for October (they also donated press box meal); Consult the game schedules in choosing Spirit Nights; Coach Simmons reported \$43,909 net raised through All-sports text fundraiser with one more day.

VP Volunteers: Lori Kobe from THS Parent Teacher Student Association (PTSA) presented information on upgraded Raptor System requirements that requires volunteers to create an account to improve security and record volunteer hours. Lori also will represent THSABC at the school-wide PTSA Volunteer Welcome meeting on Thursday at 1:00 p.m. in LGI.

VPs Concessions: Taryn and Mark have sold \$2,635.00 in the month of August (half month). We need volunteers to sign up for concessions and we are working with Becca and coaches to get the sign-ups distributed.

VP Programs: Monica reported that the programs were successful, selling 27 last week. She can adjust the number ordered each week. Program changes each week, highlighting different teams/groups of students and student organizations. Every week the cover changes and the updated actions shots are for sale.

Other Business: Trivia Night – Sept 24 in main commons; need to focus on publicizing event; still need round (\$500) and table sponsors (\$200); at least one table sponsor has been received; sport teams are encouraged to register a team but it's open to community/families; identified volunteer needs for parents vs staff needs; Keith will need to report registration payments; pizza, candy, soda and popcorn in concessions; explored signage for table sponsors and winning team prizes; each sport needs a silent auction basket due to 2126 Park Maple Drive by 9/21.
