

Hoosier Southern Lacrosse Conference (HSLC)

Conference Tournament Eligibility CRITERIA AND POLICIES – Approved 29-April-2019

Varsity

In order to be eligible for post season play within the Hoosier Southern Lacrosse Conference, each varsity team must schedule and complete a game with each member varsity program. Additional games may be schedule but only the outcome from the first meeting will be utilized for conference rankings and seeding of the end of season HSLC tournament.

Conference standings (win – loss) will be utilized for tournament seeds. In the event of a tie, head to head match outcomes and then point differentials will be utilized.

Exceptions to the policy may be granted for events such as weather or referee availability which are beyond the control of varsity coaches. These should be submitted to the HSLC coaches for approval not less than 7 days prior to the planned start of the conference tournament.

Junior Varsity

In order to be eligible for post season play within the Hoosier Southern Lacrosse Conference, each junior varsity team must schedule and complete a game with each member junior varsity program. Additional games may be schedule at the discretion of the individual programs.

Conference standings (win – loss) will NOT be utilized for tournament seeds. A blind draw will be initiated including all eligible teams not less than 7 days prior to the planned start of the conference tournament.

Exceptions to the policy may be granted for events such as weather or referee availability which are beyond the control of junior varsity coaches. These should be submitted to the HSLC coaches for approval not less than 7 days prior to the planned start of the conference tournament.

29-April-2019: HSLC Coaches approved exceptions for JV teams that did not compete with each team within the conference for the 2019 season. Coaches will review aligning the JV tournament requirements including the utilization of standings for the 2020 season.
