

Anna Sport Group Fundraiser Policy and Agreement

Anna Sports Group is a private, non profit, 501(c)(3) entity operated by volunteers. We do our best to offset as much cost for each sport as possible in the registration fees, but sometimes this is not possible. In every case, ASG will let the parents know exactly what is included and what is still needed to provide to participate. Outside of that, there should be nothing else required to participate in the sport and to be part of an ASG team.

In some cases, coaches and parents may decide to purchase additional items or fund team events throughout the season; and may elect to seek out additional funding as a team in order to purchase additional items in bulk and for the entire team.

Fund Raising Policy

Sponsored Fundraisers (If ASG is to be named in the fundraiser or the partnering entity will require a receipt from ASG for tax purposes):

- ASG sport commissioner or board members must approve the fundraiser and any marketing material prior to being posted or distributed.
- Funds must be paid directly to ASG
- Teams can then make their purchases and submit an itemized list of items purchased to be reimbursed plus any remaining balance.
- Any remaining, unused funds can be used for reimbursement throughout the active season. After the active season, any unused funds will remain with ASG and be used for future scholarships and other needs.

“Private” Fundraisers held by teams and directly with 3rd Party entities:

- ASG will need to review and approve any marketing material prior to being posted or distributed to ensure ASG is not affiliated with this event.
- Any marketing material will require a disclaimer that reads as follows: *“This is a private fundraiser event. Any activities and use of funds raised are not associated with nor the responsibility of Anna Sports Group.”*
- ASG will have no accounting for these funds and will not be liable for use, misuse, refunds or unpaid vendors.

Internal Fundraisers (Coaches and Parents):

- If asking parents to Pool or “Chipping-In” additional funds, then amounts should be nominal and agreed to by all parents.
- If not agreed to or if a parent can’t provide the funds, then other parents can offset those amounts, or the extra items should not be purchased at all.
- No parent or player should feel left out not wanting to or being able to provide extra money for extra stuff.
- If funds are raised by the parents, ASG will have no accounting for these funds and will not be liable for use, misuse, refunds or unpaid vendors.
