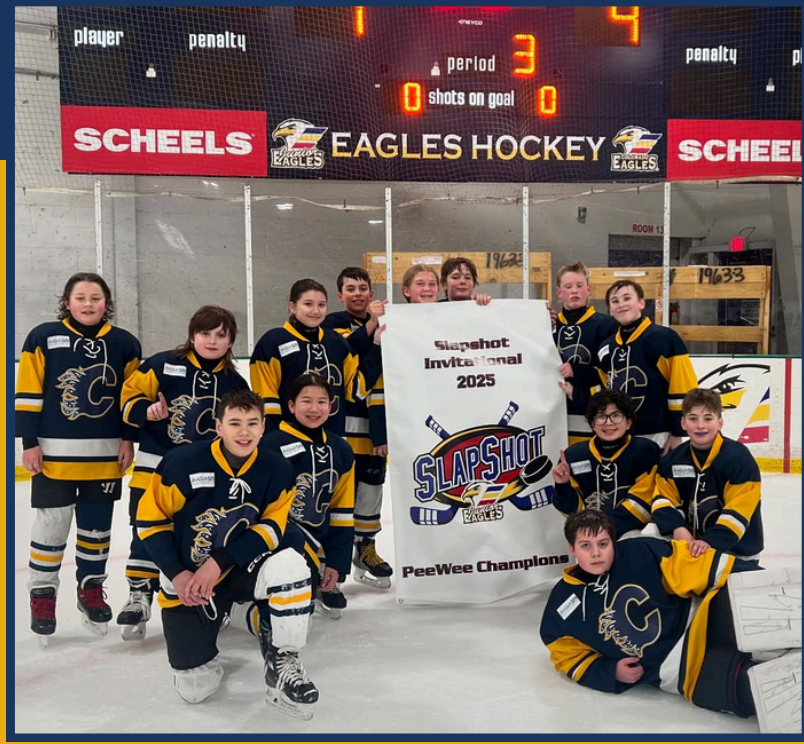


# 12A COMETS GASTROCK DOMINATE NORTHERN COLORADO SLAPSHOT INVITATIONAL
