- Assist with general venue preparation

Game Day Support

- Assist with welcoming visiting teams and spectators
- Support ticketing and entry areas as directed
- Provide general customer service support
- Assist with scoreboard operation (if trained)
- Assist Game Day Manager with basic operational tasks as needed

Post-Game Support



- Assist with field and venue clean-up
- Help store equipment and signage
- Ensure venue is returned to a tidy condition
