The Waukesha County Park System charges the following rates to enter the park:

\$25 for School Buses

\$6 for each car - Annual Park Stickers are honored

Pass on the following parking payment information to parents/attendees.

Park permit fees will not be collected when entering the park.

All vehicle license numbers will be recorded while entering and leaving the park.

How to pay - Follow the instructions on the attached document to pay online. Create an account and select and pay your fee. All payments should be made within 5 days of the event to avoid a violation.

Bus payment - You will need to record the license number of your bus and follow the instructions for payment.

Parking: Only TEAMS and Meet Workers will be allowed in the Picnic Area #3 Parking Lot. All attendees must park in designated parking.

Waukesha County Parks have a no-firearm policy. Concealed weapons are NOT allowed. They asked that this info is shared with all teams and spectators.

The WIAA discourages dogs and pets at the competition. Waukesha County Parks have a strict policy that requires all dogs to be on a leash.

Course

The course starts and finishes in Picnic Area #3 of Minooka Park. The course is a rolling course with primarily a grass and wood chip surface. Runners will cross the park roads. Spikes can be worn. The course is primarily in the front half of the park and DOES NOT include the legendary difficult hill that is in Minooka Park. The course will be lined and flagged.

MEET ENTRIES/INFORMATION

2. Click on Blackshirt Challenge.
3. Follow the directions and fill in your team's name and athletes' names. **Varsity will not be declared!!**

ENTRIES ARE DUE on: Thursday September 1st at 12:00 Noon.

A \$25.00 Late will be assessed to all schools that submit entries AFTER the deadline

DO NOT CONTACT: Waukesha South if you MISS the entry deadline. It is your responsibility to enter your team on the www.pttiming.com website.

Chip Timing: The races will be timed by PT Timing, LLC.

Awards: The 1st Place and 2nd Place teams, will each receive 8 individual medals. The top 15 individual runners receive medals.

T-SHIRTS: Please inform your athletes that multi-colored t-shirts will be on sale at the meet for around \$15.00. Limited concession stand will be available.

Park System Permit Fees

Vehicle license plate number(s) required

DAILY PARK ENTRANCE

- Car \$6/day
- Bus (11+ Passengers) \$25/day

ANNUAL PARK ENTRANCE

- Regular \$35/year
 - Double Vehicle Pkg \$55/year
- Senior (Age 60+) \$17/year
 - Double Vehicle Pkg \$29/year
- Disabled Vet/POW \$17/year
 - Double Vehicle Pkg \$29/year

DAILY LAKE ACCESS

- Carry-in \$7/day
- Trailered \$9/day

ANNUAL LAKE ACCESS

- Regular \$90/year
 - Double Vehicle Pkg \$135/year

Pay within 5 days of visit to avoid a violation ticket.
