BOARD MEMBER REPORTS:

• **COMMISSIONER**

- Budget to be discussed. iPride Winter Meeting Recap: a couple of changes were voted in. One is that the legends division has an unlimited number of courtesy runners. That doesn't affect anybody here and won't affect LVGSL because we don't have a legends division in our league. A big item that was discussed during the iPride Winter Meetings was that for this year (2026) only, the GSWS will allow one additional team per division per league to go to the series. The series will be held in Columbus; and they have the ability to host more teams. We need to discuss what that looks like for LVGSL. I am all for sending as many teams as we can as it's a great experience, but it doesn't really align with us in terms of our budget. When we present the budget in New Business, we can discuss this further. The suggestion is that if a 3rd team wants to go to WS this year, they pay for their own registration fee so that it doesn't bust the league budget.
 - Open Discussion related to GSWS: It's \$600 per team which is an increase from previous years. Player registration has gone from \$30 in previous years to \$35 last year and it will be \$50 this year. In theory, we could potentially send (4) D Teams which include the Pirates who have an automatic bid to the series based on how they finished in the series in 2025. Justin Hager motioned that the league would only be responsible for paying for the additional teams that qualify to go to the World Series as required by our by-laws. Justin would then also ask for an informal commitment to help organize a fundraiser for any additional team that would want to go. Justin mentioned that he would be happy to

work with Aces & Ales or Evolve to see if they'd host something like that for a team that wants to go.

- Voting on the motion: 17 in favor for LVGSL to only pay for those teams as required by our By-Laws. This passes with majority votes.

- **Budget Discussion:** The budget shown above was created based on 2025 expenses and revenues. This is a little more comprehensive than what we've published in previous years, but this gives a look into everything that we are expecting to bring in and what we're expecting to spend. Dave called for a vote on the budget; Justin Hager seconded the motion. 16 votes were received for budget approval, this passes.

- Governing Document Amendment Request – Justin Hager
 - Proposal to Amend: Rules of Play Section 11.7
 - **Current Verbiage:** 11.7 Courtesy Runners are permitted for one runner per inning and shall be any player on the lineup card. The batter must reach first base prior to the courtesy runner being substituted. Courtesy runner shall be in place prior to the next pitch. If the courtesy runner is on base when their scheduled official “at bat” occurs, then they should be replaced.
 - **Proposed Verbiage:** 11.7 Courtesy Runners are permitted for one runner per inning and shall be any player on the lineup card. The batter must reach first base prior to the courtesy runner being substituted. Courtesy runner shall be in place prior to the next pitch.
 - **Governing Doc Submittal Discussion:** Brett from Floyals advised: Our rules are just an exception to USA softball and although it may contradict USA softball, it’s just an exception. Justin advised: that this doesn’t apply in this case, because our rules state both things. It’s not just that our rules say in the absence of a rule 2023 will apply. We literally have one rule that says you can replace a courtesy runner and then the next rule says you can’t replace the courtesy runner.
 - Justin would accept as a friendly amendment, the removal of 2023 on 11.7.1
 - Nate: Proposes that we follow the iPride Softball courtesy running rules and then remove the extra fluff from LVGSL rules of play.
 - Votes: 16 yes votes, passes.
- Ball Allocation – Joey Markakis
 - Requesting that at least one new ball be placed on each field for games and then utilizing the older balls as back up for each game.
 - Joey wants to ensure we’re using a new ball in spring ball, Dave will discuss this further with Joey offline.
- Open Floor:
 - Jonathan: It was brought to my attention that someone was speaking with one of my players that if they aren’t totally in it to be very competitive, then they shouldn’t sign up for the league. Not sure who said it, but I just want to remind people that everyone is welcome regardless of their skill level.
 - Brett: Reminder that March 1 is Week 1 of Spring league and the Bar of the Week is Quadz, so we would appreciate it if people showed up to hang out.
