Sun Prairie Ice Arena Safe Operation Policy **(September 20th, 2020)**

1. Everyone must enter the facility using the main lobby entrance ONLY (West side entrance is used for Dance Students only).
2. Players will not be allowed to enter the facility until 15 minutes before the start of on-ice activities. Anyone arriving earlier than 15 minutes before their start time should wait outside of the facility and be socially distanced from others.
3. Players must arrive to the facility fully dressed, with the exception of skates and helmets. Players can enter the facility with either skates worn with skate guards or can carry skates in and put them on once inside the rink.
4. Masks must be worn at all times while in the facility (must cover the mouth and nose). Masks must be worn until helmets are put on and must be worn once their helmet is removed after their session.
5. Hockey Bags are not allowed in the facility (except for Goalies). Backpacks are allowed.
6. Whenever possible, players should use the restroom at home prior to leaving for the rink in an effort to limit bathroom use at the facility.
7. Goalies may enter the facility 20 minutes prior to get dressed (it is recommended that goalies arrive dressed as much as possible).
8. Teams/Groups will be allowed to use locker rooms only for putting skates on.
 - a. Players must be physically distanced while in the locker room.
 - b. For age groups where parents need to assist players with equipment (MiniMites, Mites & Squirts ONLY), one adult may help get their player's skates on but then must exit the facility immediately.
9. Players/Teams must use their assigned locker rooms. This ensures locker rooms and common areas are being cleaned and disinfected properly.
10. Players MUST bring their own water bottle to the rink that is clearly marked with the player's first name initial and full last name. The container should be re-sealable. Players should NOT plan on refilling their containers at the rink.
11. Dry land activities inside the arena are not allowed.
12. EVERYONE must exit the facility using the Cardinal Rinks Northeast exit door located next to the automated skate sharpeners and vending machine.
13. Spectators/fans/parents are not allowed in the facility unless otherwise noted above.
 - a. SPYHA Representatives and Team Representatives are allowed.
 - b. Players that need Parent medical/emotional supervision must coordinate through SPYHA/Rink Management Personnel.

Ultimately it is the parent's/players choice if, and when to return to Hockey. Each family and skater understands that they participate at their own risk!

If you are sick, do not feel well, or have been diagnosed with COVID-19, you will not be allowed to enter the facility and should stay home for a minimum of 14 days until symptom free!

Before Practice

1. Coaches need to inform rink staff if extra nets are needed before practice starts. Zamboni doors will **NOT** be opened once players are handling/shooting pucks.
2. Players are **NOT** allowed to enter the ice surface until the Zamboni doors are closed.
3. Players may not sit on the boards at the benches as the ice is being resurfaced.
4. Players need to maintain social distancing while waiting to go on the ice.

On Ice Activities

1. Whenever possible, coaches should be promoting social distancing on the ice, while recognizing that there may be times of close contact by players.
2. Avoid using player benches.
3. Players should not leave the ice during a practice unless absolutely necessary.
4. Coaches should avoid talking face-to-face with players, as well as avoid contact with players whenever possible. Physical contact may be necessary when assisting a young player or a player with a disability (helping up or adjusting equipment), but whenever possible, coaches should provide assistance without physical contact
5. Prior to the completion of the ice time, players should be excused from the rink one by one and through different exit points of the rink. Do not ask players to participate in picking up pucks or other equipment from the ice.
6. No Games or Scrimmaging Allowed.

After Practice

1. Players have 15 minutes after their session to exit the facility.
2. Have players put on their shoes or skate guards so that they can leave quickly in the same marked common space.
3. Players and parents are to follow physical distancing guidelines when leaving the facility.
4. EVERYONE must exit the facility using the Cardinal Rinks Northeast exit door located next to the automated skate sharpeners and vending machine.

Safety Protocols

1. Any team or user group that has a confirmed case of Covid-19 will not be allowed to enter the facility for 14 days.
2. Players/Teams that may have had on-ice contact with a confirmed case will be notified by SP Ice and/or SPYHA representatives.

Facility Cleaning Protocols

1. Rink Staff will clean/disinfect after every user group enters the facility (following the predetermined traffic flow).
2. Rink Staff will clean/disinfect locker rooms beginning exactly 15 minutes after the groups session end time. This time is needed for the disinfectant to have the appropriate time to make restrooms safe for the next user group.
3. Rink Staff will wear the appropriate PPE while disinfecting.
