REGISTRATION:

The registration desk is located on the second floor just inside the doors to the competition rink. Registration desk will open one hour before the first event of the day. All skaters are expected to arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of their scheduled event. Skaters need to check in at the registration desk before their first event. Skaters will then be required to check in with the ice monitor before each practice ice session and competitive event. Click [here](#) for event schedule.

CREDENTIALS AND ADMISSION:

- **Spectators:** Tickets must be purchased for the Regional Singles Challenge and the Sectional Dance Challenge and may be purchased online [here](#) or at the door.
- **Chaperones:** A Chaperone Pass may be purchased at registration for \$35, which will allow you to enter the skater lobby and the arena to watch but will not allow you down the secure competitor hallways.
- **Skaters:** Skaters will receive their credentials at the registration table.
- **Coaches:** Only coaches who are listed in the EMS Skater Profile and fully compliant within U.S. Figure Skating and SafeSport guidelines may receive a credential. Coaches must show photo ID at the registration table and pick up their own credential. Replacement Fee for lost Coaches credential is \$35.

Credentials must be worn at all times at the competition facility and are non-transferable.

PROGRAMS:

Stop by the registration desk to purchase an official event program during open registration hours. Official Event Program is available for \$25 each.

LOCKER ROOMS:

Male and Female locker rooms are located along the competition hallway. There is one Chaperoned locker room available for skaters 11 years and younger at the head of the competition hallway. PACIFIC COAST SECTIONAL SINGLES FINAL & U.S. DANCE FINAL ADVANCEMENT:

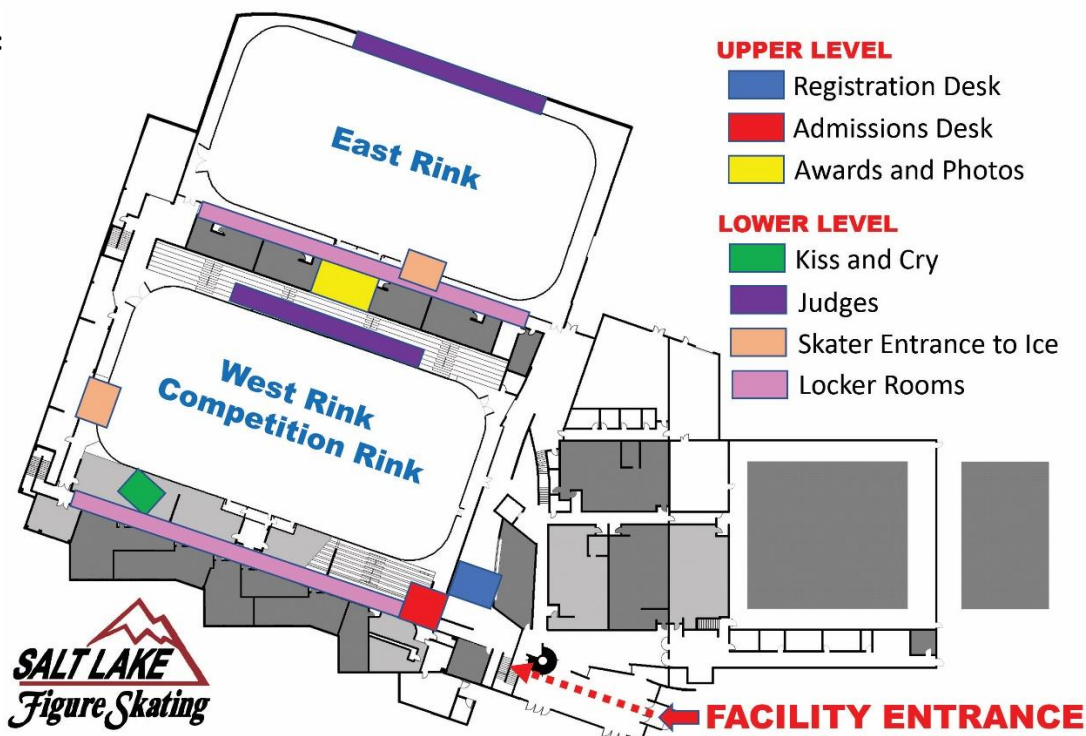
Advancing skaters will receive an email notification from U.S. Figure Skating Headquarters no later than the Tuesday following the competition outlining next steps.
