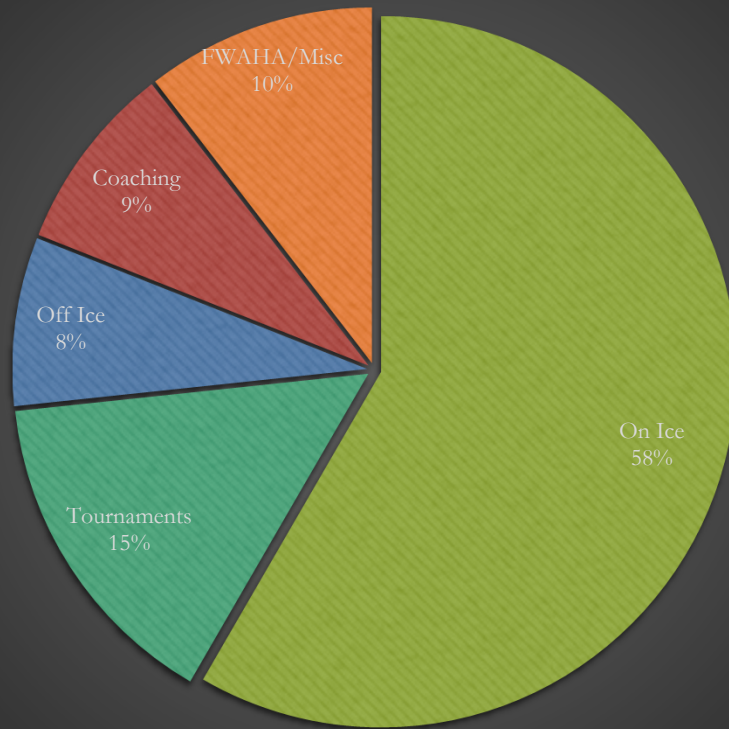

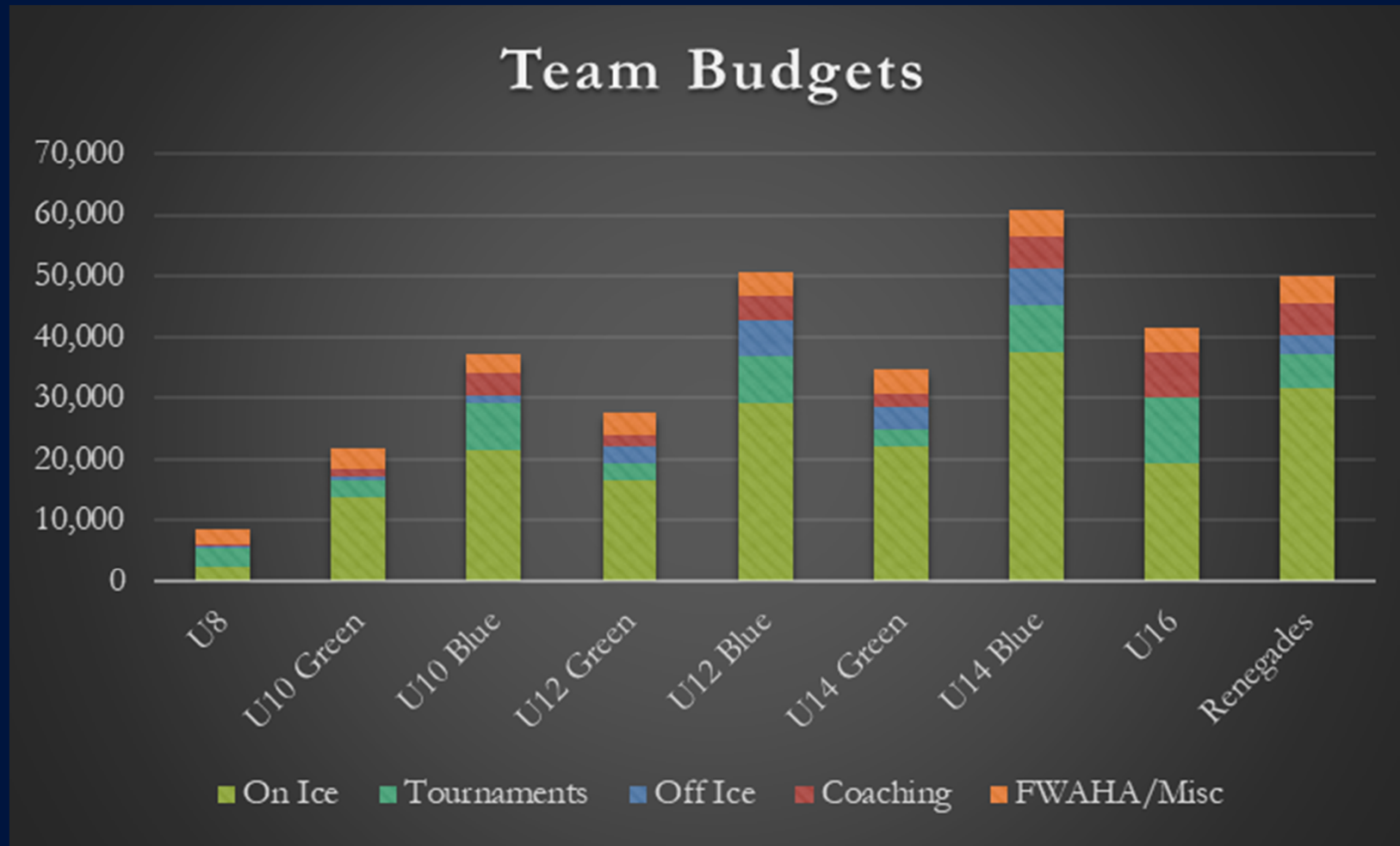

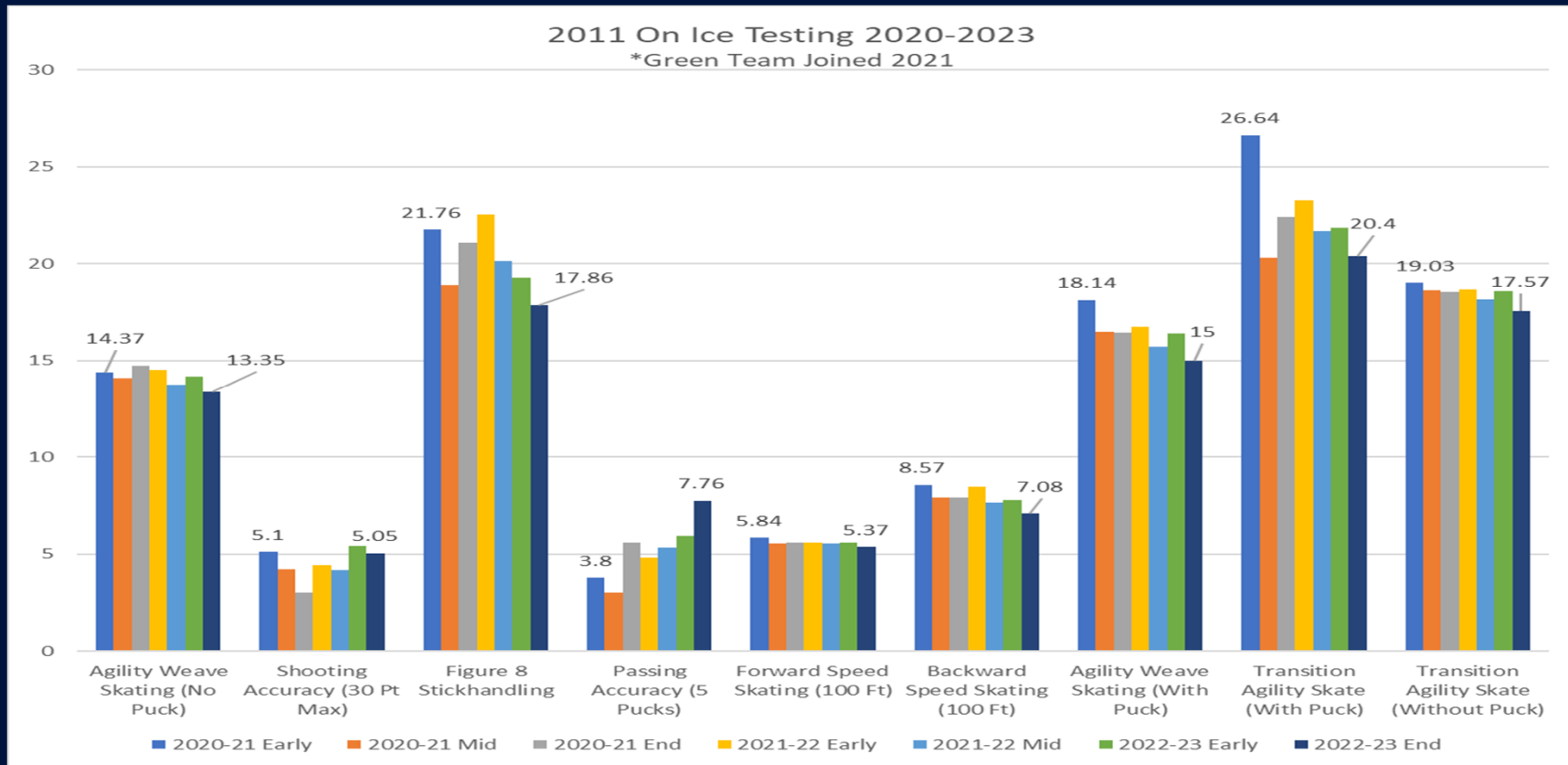

# FWAHA | 2023-24 Off Ice Skills

- Off ice skills will consist of techniques that can be practiced off ice for implementation/improvement on ice
  - Shooting, passing, stick handling, body contact, game strategy....etc.
- All training will be age appropriate
- Coaches at each age group will be able to identify shortfalls/problem areas that can be worked on during this time as well.
- 14U/16U Blue Teams Positional Skills
  - Each session dedicated to concepts covered during on ice skills
  - Forwards = 10 skates
  - Defensemen/Goalies = 10 skates

# FWAHA | Tryout Process – High School

- Players must be enrolled in a high school & registered for tryouts
- Any Player outside of Allen County who was not rostered on a varsity team last year will attend the Open Draft Skate (held on 5/2)
- The 4 Varsity Teams each hold 2 Tryout Sessions and will either roster a full team or have spots available (18 Skaters, 2 Goalies\*)
- Teams with open spots will draft from the open draft, which includes all players outside of Allen County (not previously rostered) and all Cut Players (5/25)
- Draft Order is established by final records in City Play
- Renegades will select from the Open Draft as well

- Evaluators at Call Backs As well

- Final Team Rosters are determined by Evaluators, Head Coach, Coaching Director
