### **Titans fall to Evanston in sectional semifinal**

The Boys basketball team battled Evanston but came up short Tuesday, losing to the Wildkits 68-60 in the Nile North regional semifinal

From the Glenview Lantern:

*"I give our kids a lot of credit," Ralston said. "There were as many times in this game where they could have given up. I've seen teams in those situations, and they stop playing, and our kids didn't. There was no quit in them."*

*South battled adversity right from the start when Evanston started the game with a 9-0 win, making its first 3-pointers. The Wildkits continued to fight off the Titans, running out to a 12-3 advantage*

*before the Titans battled back to trail 21-15 at the end of the first quarter.*

*That was how the rest of the game went, as Evanston's fast pace and athleticism forced South to play in a different style it didn't want. The Wildkits continued to apply pressure against point guard Will King, limiting the sets they could run.*

*Evanston made eight three-point attempts in the first half despite the constant contested players took — the team led 40-32 heading into halftime.*

*"I can't fault what we did on offense," Ralston said. "In the third quarter, we just didn't get enough that was going our way. The calls just weren't there."*

*South battled back to make it a nine-point game heading into the fourth quarter and continued to battle, making it a 55-50 game. But Evanston moved the ball, taking time off the clock and limiting what the Titans could do with little time left.*

*The Titans continued to battle late in the game, fouling and applying pressure, led by a 32-game performance by junior Dom Martinelli, which made Ralston.*

*"That's the way this team has played all season long," Ralston said. "It didn't matter what the score was, it didn't matter what the time was on the clock, they were going to keep on fighting until we got on to the buzzer."*

*The loss ended a turnaround season for the Titans program. South flipped its record, winning 24 games this season while also winning its first IHSA regional title in 10 years.*

*The loss also marked the end of Phil Ralston's second year as head coach of the Titans. While the loss was hard for all the players, including the seniors who bought in Ralston's program when he arrived at GBS, the night showed the progress the program made in the past year, leaving hope for where the program can go in the coming years.*

*"We've come a long way in two years," Ralston said. "I told them they're the ones who did it. They get to be the ones who helped build a winning program. They need to take the pride in the big turnaround."*

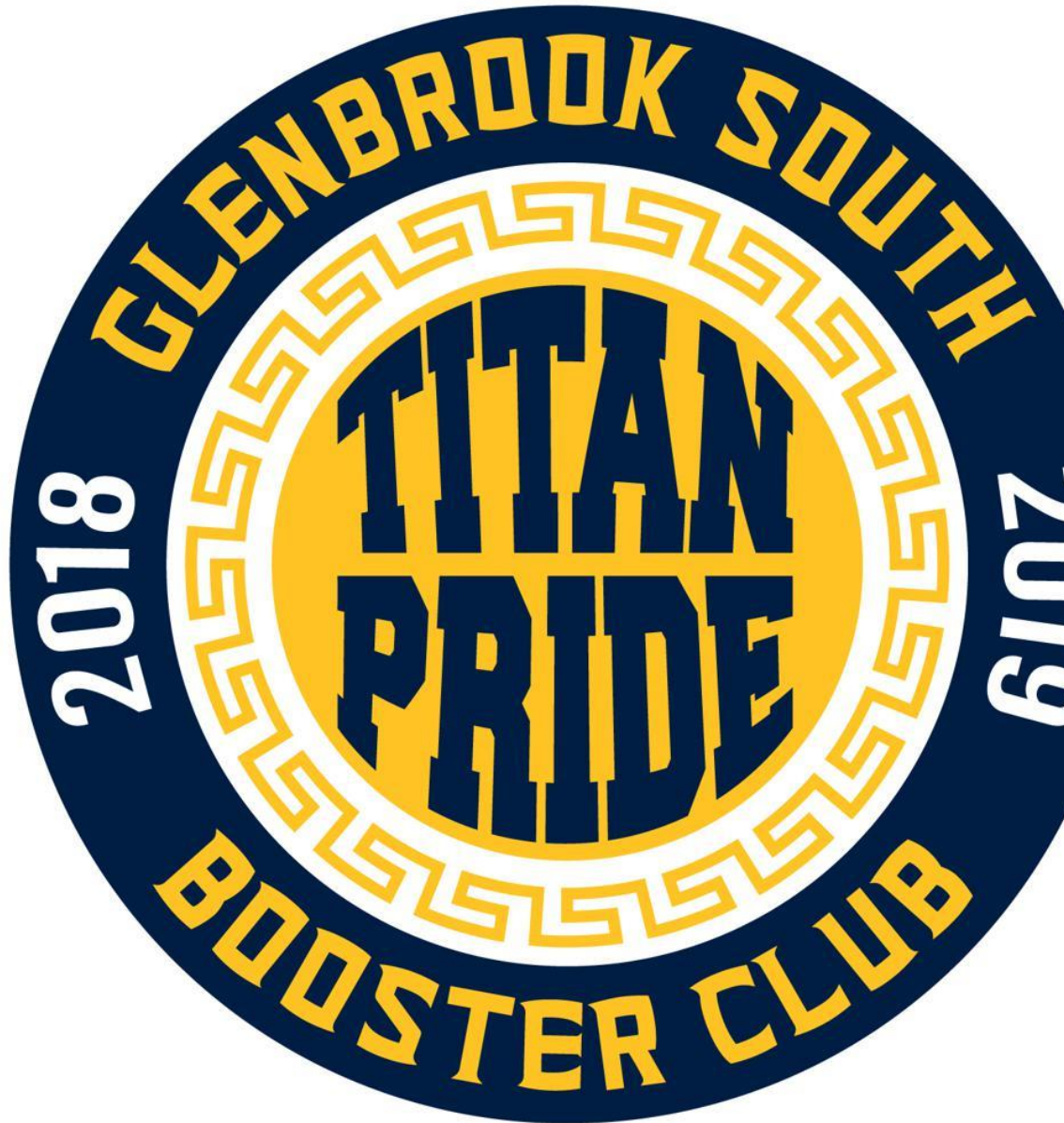
Step 2: Parents sign in to your Parent Portal on PowerSchool. Go to Sports Survey, choose the sport your student would like to try out for and click submit.

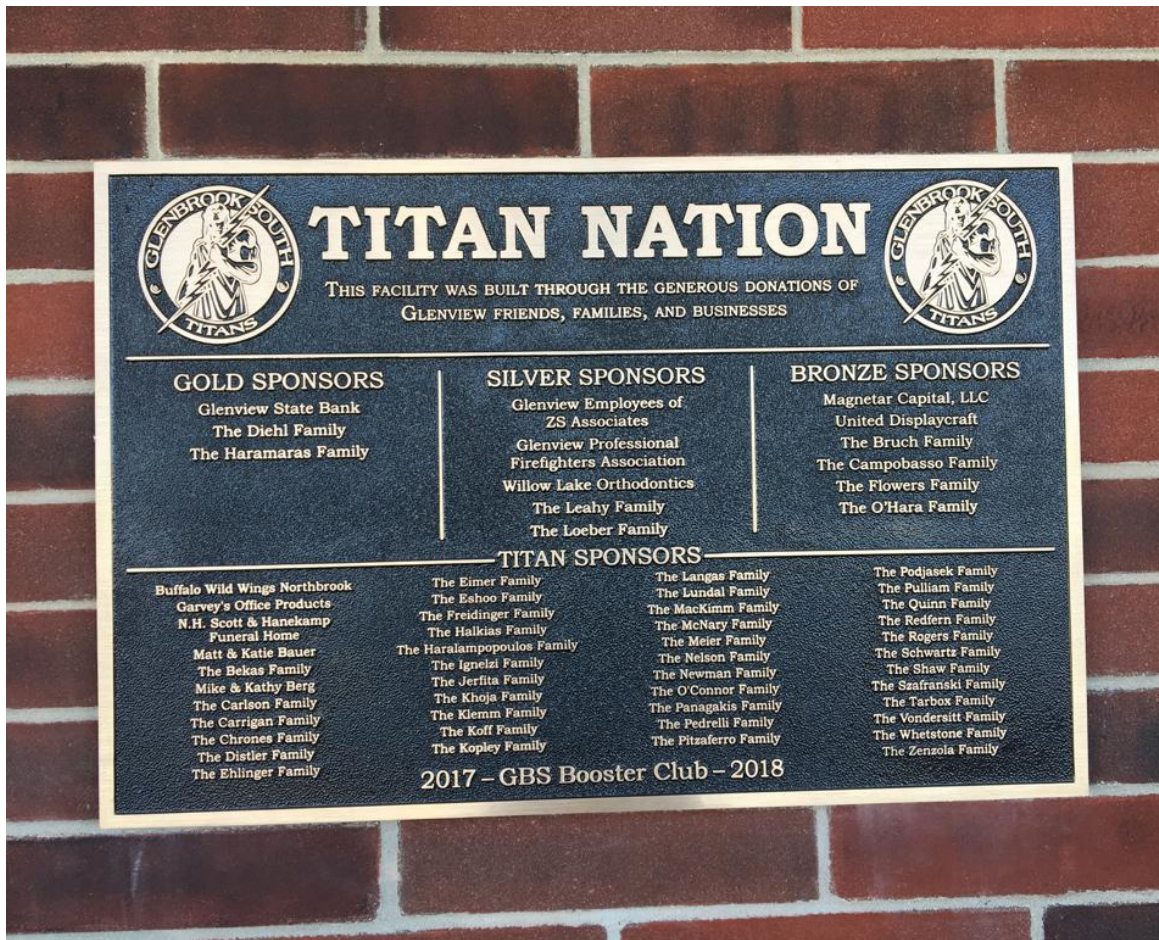
