



COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

The safety guidelines listed below are additional measures that the GBESYB (Green Bay East Side Youth Baseball) organization will be taking before, during, and after a youth baseball game. All other key prevention strategies by the CDC and Wisconsin Department of Health will be followed, in order to promote safe and healthy social distancing.

Entering or Exiting Parks:

1. All players, coaches, and umpires must enter and exit through their designated dugouts.

Spectator Viewing:

1. Please limit the number of family members that will be attending the game. Social distancing guidelines must be followed.
2. Parents and spectators are encouraged to view the game from the outfield. The suggested area for viewing the game is along the foul lines starting at or past 1st/3rd base and extending to the outfield and in the outfield area.
3. Parents and spectators are encouraged to wear masks at all times.
4. Only players, up to three coaches per team and the umpire(s) are allowed on the field of play.
5. We ask all spectators to do their part to create a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone involved by following all guidelines. Spectators will be asked to observe and remind each other of the safety guidelines as needed.

Dugout (Team Personnel):

1. Hand and equipment sanitizing between innings is recommended.
2. Teams are encouraged to limit the number of players and coaches at any given time in the dugouts. These individuals (players, coaches or any combination) will be asked to adhere to social distancing guidelines throughout the game. All other team personnel must practice social distancing in the extended area of the dugout.
3. Assistant coaches should be provided with a designated standing area (6 feet from players) when coaching the bases.
4. All coaches and players are encouraged to wear masks while not in the field of play.
5. After each game, teams must sanitize the dugouts and surrounding areas.
6. Coaches will be asked to observe and remind players, fans and umpires of the safety guidelines as needed.
7. Spectators are not allowed in the dugouts.

Game Protocol:

1. At the pregame meeting and throughout the game, coaches and umpires will not be allowed to shake hands or have any physical contact with each other. All parties must maintain social distancing guidelines.
2. Any and all physical gestures of celebration are prohibited.
3. At the conclusion of the game, players will be asked to forego the sportsmanship line. Instead we are asking for each team to line up on their respective foul line and “tip their cap” as a salute to the other team to promote sportsmanship.
4. If more than one game will be played on a field in the same day/night, there will be 15 minutes between games to give each teams time sanitize and vacate the dugout/field before the second game begins.
5. All post game team huddles are to follow social distancing guidelines and masks are encouraged for both players and coaches.
6. Designated areas will be assigned for teams to warm up before games begin.

Equipment:

1. The GBESYB organization will provide hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes to be used before, during and after the games. We ask coaches and players to use sanitizer if and when they come into contact with the ball or any other players, coaches, or shared equipment (bases).
2. Refrain from sharing equipment in general. This includes but is not limited to bats, helmets, and catcher’s equipment.
3. It is suggested that each player has a designated area, away from other players, for their personal equipment.
4. Each team needs to provide their own baseballs for when they are in the field. Each team is responsible for switching out their baseballs each inning or sanitizing their baseballs/ as best as possible.
5. Each team should have a designated coach responsible for sanitizing each ball and all equipment used in order to prevent unnecessary cross contamination.
6. Spectators/fans/families are asked not to retrieve foul balls. The designated coach from each respective team will retrieve foul balls and sanitize before returning to the competition.

Umpires:

1. Umpires are encouraged to officiate the game from behind the pitcher's mound, while practicing social distancing with all fielders. This will limit the number of people around home plate and will still allow the umpire to call the game and see the whole field.
2. Umpires are encouraged to wear facemask at all times.
3. Umpires should not handle baseballs.

Food/Beverage/Hydration:

1. All players, coaches, and umpires need to label their personal water bottles that are to be kept in their individual designated area.
2. All food such as sunflower seeds, gum and snacks will be eliminated from the dugouts and park.

Concession Stand/Bathrooms:

1. Concessions will be open for the season. Concession stands will be cleaned and sanitized before and after nightly use. The GBESYB board along with the local park and rec departments will reevaluate the use of the concession stand as the season progresses.
2. All volunteers will be asked to wear masks while in the concession stands.
3. Only two volunteers allowed in the concessions stand at any time. No players or umpires are allowed inside the concession stands.
4. Bathrooms will be cleaned and sanitized after nightly use.

If you have any symptoms at all:

1. Stay home except to get medical care.
2. Contact appropriate health officials.
3. Separate yourself from other people.
4. Monitor your symptoms.
5. Contact the GBESYB to confirm case.
