- IV. **Presidents Report – Cameron Peuse:**
 - a. Alex and Alan are present to speak
 - a. Alan- would like to bring back a UPSL team, there is a team that is ready to go
 1. There is an operating budget of \$15,000 for the year, historically the club has donated \$5,000, the rest will need to be donated/fundraised
 - a. The club donated \$5k and Rudy paid the rest out of pocket
 - b. Tony had mentioned to Alan that the club had paid 100%
 - i. There is a paper trail of what Rudy had done to get covered, we will also need to look into past board meeting minutes but the club has never given 100%
 - ii. Because of the lack of UPSL last year, Grillin' and Chillin' had to seek other volunteers and those spots are not guaranteed
 - c. Refs are paid more because they are higher ranked
 2. Sponsors are getting lined up, \$6k
 - a. Is there a rule on banners/advertisements
 - i. The field is owned by the city, banners could go up every game, but they would need to be removed after
 1. Zip ties/ special brackets can hold them in place
 2. The city is extremely picky, would need to verify with them
 3. Sponsorship ideas-
 - a. Primetime barbershop
 - i. Club promotes on social media and doesn't enter into another contract with any other barbershop
 - ii. \$40/cut M-W \$10 goes back to the club, at minimum \$1300 back to the club
 4. Fundraising ideas-
 - a. Run soccer camp within the club, can charge any amount
 - b. Organize a soccer tournament, 1 weekend, 6 teams, \$500/team
 - c. Indoor tournament or possibly begin an indoor league

 - 1. \$20 donation

 - a. Check in with 8th grade players, conduct player evals
 - b. Alan is willing to train coaches
 - i. A lot of coaches coach because they have kids on the team

 - a. 6 weeks, twice a week for 1 hour, twice a year
 - i. November when rec ends and in March before tryouts
 - b. Volunteers would need to get a background check
 - c. Alex has created a program already
 - 2. The cost would ideally be free
 - 3. We can create a program in GotSport under tryouts to keep track of reg. info and it won't charge the account
 - a. There needs to be an electronic consent form
 - b. May be easier to do a google form and it would still be able to be signed online
 - 4. Start the last 2 weeks of March so that it ends right before tryouts
 - 5. We need to meet with Austin about the cost of the indoor field, we would need 2 hrs min. M/W, other coaches can help out
 - 6. What funding would be needed?
 - a. Size 4 balls, possibly field costs
 - b. Create a materials list and we can get it
 - 7. Anyone helping needs to be over 18
 - c. Motion to move forward with the grassroots program
