2021 Fall COVID-19 Guidelines

Below are the Fall 2021 COVID-19 Guidelines for Buckhead Baseball. **IMPORTANT - these guidelines are the minimum requirements** for Coaches, Players, and Families at Buckhead Baseball. **IN ALL CASES**, if your child's healthcare provider, or school, requires additional precautions, longer periods of Quarantine or Isolation, then those requirements take priority and supersede the guidelines outlined below. **IN NO EVENT**, should your child attend an event at Buckhead Baseball if they are ineligible to participate in school or other outside activities.

Evaluating Health Status before coming to Buckhead Baseball:

1. Buckhead Baseball requires everyone to stay at home when they are not feeling well or displaying symptoms of COVID-19, when household members are sick or displaying symptoms of COVID-19, when a household member impacted by COVID-19 is in isolation or when required by a healthcare provider to isolate or quarantine themselves
2. If an unvaccinated individual comes in "close contact" (within 6 feet for at least 15 minutes) with someone impacted by COVID-19 that individual must quarantine for a period of 7 to 10 days. A negative COVID-19 test will be required to return after 7-days. Vaccinated individuals will not be asked to quarantine due to close contact exposure unless they begin to show symptoms
3. If you have a COVID-19 test pending, you cannot return to Buckhead Baseball until you have received your results
4. If an individual tests positive for COVID-19, or believes they had COVID-19, and had symptoms they are not to return to Buckhead Baseball until: 10 days since your symptoms first appeared and 24-hours with no fever and other symptoms are improving. If an individual tests positive for COVID-19 but had no symptoms you can return after 10 days have passed since you had a positive viral test

Face Coverings & Other Important Items:

- For anyone who is **not vaccinated** (Players, Coaches & Parents) - masks (covering your nose and mouth) are **required** at all times in the dugouts and all other indoor spaces to include the Lloyd Center, restrooms, and board room
- For anyone who is not vaccinated (aged 2 or older), masks are strongly encouraged around the park, to include the bleachers, concession lines and other common areas
- No sharing of equipment; if any equipment is shared it must be cleaned and disinfected before being utilized by another player
- Practice social distancing - stay 6 ft away from people who don't live in your household
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Wash your hands often
