Notice Of Race

Notice of Race (amended 1/23/2025)

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The organizing authority (OA) for this regatta is the Cedar Lake Yacht Club (CLYC)
Preamble – The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule and for which the Jury may refuse to hold a hearing. This changes RRS 60.1(a) and 63.1 as stated below. The notation '[DP]' in a rule means that the penalty for breaking this rule may, at the discretion of the Jury, be more or less than a single disqualification.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all invited X Class boats.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing an official entry form available online only at www.clyc.com > Regattas > Blue Chip

The entry form is considered part of the NOR even though it is a separate form.

2.3 All entries must be received by Thursday July 31st at 5pm to avoid late penalties. Internet registrations require credit card payment.

2.4 Entry is not complete until entrants have signed the entry form and warranted that no changes to the yacht or its equipment has been made since it was last weighed and certified.

3. FEES

3.1 The entry fee is \$225.00

3.2 Entries received after July 31st, 2025 will be subject to an additional fee of \$35.00. No entry will be accepted after 11:59PM on August 5th

3.3 The entry fee includes skipper and crew lunches, shirts, and the Friday night dinner and party. Lunch will be available for purchase for \$15 for instructors and other guests. There will also be a \$10 fee for the junior dinner party for non-competitors.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1 A maximum of five races may be sailed with no more than four races sailed in one day.

4.2 The schedule of events is as follows:

Thursday, August 7, 2025

1600 - 2000 Registration/Check-in/Launch

1200 - 2000 Launching available

Friday, August 8, 2025

0700 - 0815 Registration/Check-in/Launch

0825 Competitors' briefing at the CLYC Signal Mast

0930 1st Warning Signal

- The time of the warning signal for subsequent races will be posted except when races are sailed back-to-back.

Saturday, August 9, 2025

- Warning Signal to be posted on the Official Notice Board by 1800 Friday.
- No warning signal will be made after 1200 hours if three races have been completed.
- Under no conditions will a race be started after 1300 hours on Saturday.
- Awards ceremony after racing at regatta headquarters.

5. LAUNCHING

Launching is available on Thursday, August 7th between 1200-2000. An anchor with a 20 foot line is sufficient, and boats may be anchored in the bay to the north of the club. Dry sailing is permitted. Taxi boats will be available to assist during these hours.

Cedar Lake Yacht Club practices and supports Wisconsin Administrative Code NR 40.

The invasive species rule. Therefore it is expected that all boats, both power and sail will be free of all vegetation before you launch and upon leaving the lake. Furthermore, bilge water must also be absent before launching and upon leaving.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

RRS Appendix S "Standard Sailing Instructions" shall apply, except as modified by the Supplemental Sailing Instructions (the Supplement). The Supplement will be available before the start of the regatta at www.clyc.com under "Regattas" and "Blue Chip", during registration at the regatta site, and on the official bulletin board during the regatta. This meets the requirements of RRS 25.

7. VENUE

Races will be conducted on the navigable waters of Big Cedar Lake, located near Slinger, WI.

8. THE COURSES

The courses will be as specified in RRS Appendix S or as modified in the Supplement.

9. SCORING

9.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

9.2 Each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. This changes RRS A2.1

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

10.1 "The Race Committee will be communicating among themselves and to the fleet before, during and after racing on the competitor channel which is 72. After the start of the race, the race committee will change to the RC channel which is 69. Competitors are only to transmit or receive radio transmissions on the RC channel in case of emergency or to notify the race committee of withdrawal from the race."

11. PRIZES

The trophy presentation will be held at the Cedar Lake Yacht Club after the last race. Individual race trophies will be awarded along with skipper and crew trophies for the first 5 places in the final standings. There is a traveling championship trophy.
