PAHL STANDING REPORTS:

EXECUTIVE ADMINSTRATOR

- Website. Trying to make it look better. Navigation changed a lot. Trying to highlight hockey more. Administration type items are on left side of webpage. Right side is more player focused. Logos link to club's website.
- August 23rd will be the TMC training session, so the team manager and the coordinators will meet to go over everything.
- New scoresheet. The scoresheet is out there to use but the information isn't ready to populate for the preseason. You are welcome to use but you will have to use stickers or write in names.
- Scheduling meetings. The dates are on the website under the calendar on operations and will be at Ice Castle. This year they start in September.
- USA Hockey rosters. Most of the USA Hockey rosters are built. We had some issues with the registrars not getting a login from USA Hockey and I think they are resolved. This year, I am sending an email to registrars with a file in it so that they can just put all the links in one spot and send it at one time.
- Safe Sport. Safe Sport expires after 12 months. The person with expiring Safe Sport, will receive about 6 emails notifying them of the expiration.
- Medics and Referees. Take care of medics and referee scheduling for games and do not wait until the last minute. Make sure the medics meet the rules. We cannot take shortcuts. In the past, as a courtesy service, we collected ACT 15 clearances from your officials. We are no longer going to do that anymore.
- 8U players cannot move up to 10U. We have had some questions about it recently and we just wanted to reiterate the rule.
- Rule Book. If anyone is interested in serving on the Rules Committee, please send me an e-mail. We may not start meeting until December or January but, it's nice to get that out there now.
- Free Penguins Game. They are not going to have the free Pen's game this year. Participation has declined over the years and they want to try to do something better and bigger to benefit our league. Nothing concrete at this time.
- Penguins Foundation has provided Flex Coach to our teams, our coaches in the past. That contract is on their table for signatures so, within the next week or so that should get finalized.

COMPETITION

- We are following procedure similar to last year for U12 to U18 for preseason games. We need the Game Report Form, the one that's on the website. Please fill out the sheet online and do not hand write. Send to the Statisticians. Do not send the Scoresheets for preseason games. If we need them, we will request them. Once games are scheduled, please send the schedule.
- We had hoped to have a nice distributed system that registrars would be able to access and do reports this year. Unfortunately, MAPS is doing a major software upgrade and it is delayed until November. However, a large reason for the delay is some of the customization they are doing is for our league.

DISCIPLINE

- I have been working with Jill now that we have a player movement list to track down the players that have carry over suspensions from last season.
- Instruct your coaches that any questions on a game misconduct or a match penalty, needs to be taken care of before they leave the ice. Coaches are going to have to do their due diligence.
