



Mount Pleasant Athletics – “Ticket 2 Play” Process

A Step-By-Step Guide

Step 1 – Online Registration

- Beginning on June 1st, 2021 student athletes and their parents will be able to register online to participate in the athletic program at Mount Pleasant HS. To register, visit www.cabarruscountyathletics.com/mountpleasanthhs and click on the “2021-2022 Mount Pleasant Athletics Registration Button” located in the blue box in the middle of the homepage. The registration process takes about 15 minutes and is REQUIRED for participation in the athletic program at Mount Pleasant. During online registration, it is important you select **ALL** the sports you plan to play during the 2021-2022 school year. Even if you are not sure, go ahead and select **ANY** and **ALL** sports you might play during the upcoming school year. You will complete the registration process on a yearly basis, but your SportsEngine account will remain with you throughout your high school career.

Step 2 – Medical Physical

- In order to participate in the athletic program at Mount Pleasant you must always have a current medical physical on file (new form from NCHSAA- can find under Documents & Forms). Physicals are valid for 365 days (including a 30-day grace period is allowed by NCHSAA). Once your medical physical is complete you **MUST** turn in a hard copy to the athletic trainers or to the front office. (see below).

Note: If you plan to participate in off-season workouts you **MUST** have an online registration and an updated physical on file prior to your initial day of participation. It is advised that all student athletes participating in off-season workouts e-mail a copy of their medical physical to the Athletic Trainers prior to participation.

Step 3 – Ticket 2 Play

- To be issued a “Ticket 2 Play” for your sport you **MUST** have already registered online (beginning 6/1/21) and have a current medical physical already on file or in-hand ready to turn in. **We will issue “Tickets 2 Play” between 9am-11:00am on Wednesday July 28th & Thursday July 29th.** If you show up on the first day of tryouts with your physical, there is no guarantee you will receive your “Ticket 2 Play” that day. “Ticket 2 Play” is the final step in the eligibility process and includes online registration verification, medial physical verification, residency verification, and grade/attendance checks. Once you complete the “Ticket 2 Play” process you will be given a “ticket” to give to your coach on the first day of tryouts/practice. If you plan to play multiple sports, you will repeat the “Ticket 2 Play” process seasonally.
