FCYSA is solely a non-paid volunteer based organization. The more help, the merrier!

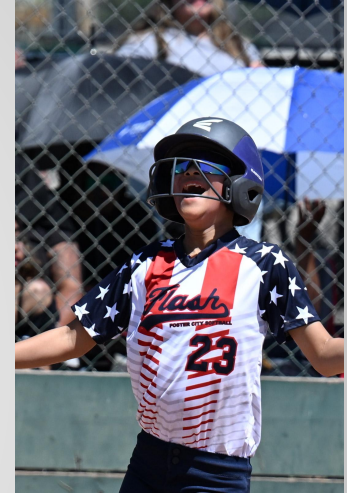

6U & 8U Division Details

- Season runs from February 28th to May 2nd
- Practices can start the week of February 9th
- **6U Division**
 - Games will be in Foster City and Belmont
 - 6u - 60 minute game once/week
- **8U Division**
 - Games will be in FC, Belmont, San Carlos
 - 8U - 90 minute games once/week
- Coaches will supply game and practice schedules
 - 6u - 1 practice per week
 - 8u - 1-2 practices per week



10U & 12U Division Details

- Practices began week of February 9th
- Season runs from February 28th to May 2nd10u & 12u - No more than 4 softball days per week (includes games)
- League Season Starts Saturday, February 28th
 - Peninsula League (multiple Peninsula cities)
 - Typically 2 games per week
 - Home games at Sea Cloud Park
 - Away games at other Peninsula Cities

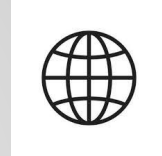
