

EPBBA In-House Coach Roles (Grades 9-12)



Head Coach:

As a Head Coach, you are responsible for running practices, setting the lineup for games, and managing player rotations and behavior. You are also responsible for entering game scores as outlined below.

For Grades 9-12 In-House, there is typically 1 practice to start the season and 2 games per week the rest of the way. Events are typically held at the Activity Center on Tuesday or Wednesday, and Sunday. The season starts in late-November / early December and finishes in late February / first weekend of March.

Head Coaches are asked to be present at the team draft. The grade-level commissioner will organize the draft for your grade.

Assistant Coach:

As an Assistant coach, you will support the Head Coach.

Team Communications:

- If you haven't reached out to your team before the first practice, please send a note after the practice and before your first game. Remind all your players to check the schedule for their games.
- Please use the EPBBA email system or Sport Engine app for your team communication.

Entering Game Scores:

Head Coaches are responsible for entering scores into the Sports Engine app after each game. The Head Coach of the winning team should enter the score immediately after the game.

Checking your Team Schedule:

- Schedules are posted to the website in late November.
- Schedules can also be found in the Sport Engine app after your son has been assigned to a team.

Technical Foul Reporting:

ALL Technical fouls must be reported to the Grade Commissioner by the coaches. BOTH coaches should contact the commissioner with this information. Coaches who accumulate multiple technical fouls during the season may receive additional disciplinary action as determined by the EPBBA Code of Conduct Policy.

Background Checks and Concussion Training:

- All Head and Assistant Coaches must complete a background check each year.
All Head Coaches must complete concussion training every 3 years (you will be asked to submit your certificate).
