Treasurer's Report (McCusker)

- No budget has been established for 2021.
- Budget Meeting scheduled for mid-November.
- League is OK financially
 - Bank issued 6-month layoff and will resume mortgage payments in November.
 - Approximately \$45,000 in account.
 - Bank approached League about refinancing in January – approximately \$170,000 left on Mortgage.
- No Fall Season Fundraiser was held which totaled an estimated \$5,000 profit missed.
- Talks with Gianni/Corby for Fundraiser in Spring has begun.
