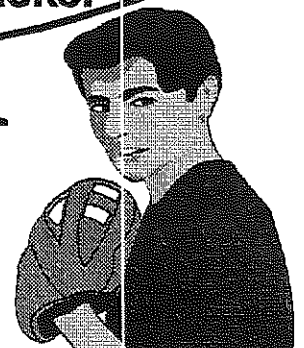
Village People Vs. Prime Time-Game 2
