This does not mean we cannot accept donations to our organization we just can't co-brand CYH and Kraft Hockeyville.

There has been discussions on what type of activities to have throughout the weekend prior to the game. Again, all proceeds from these events will benefit the Clinton Arena fund. These rules are dictated by NHL and Kraft and formal disclosures were signed by all member to abide by these rules.

Merchandise will be ordered within the next couple weeks. NHL will provide all the merchandise, royalty free and will only charge the community for the cost of the items. Any profit will be donated to the arena fund.

The LOC invited Nick Grimmer from the Community Foundation to give a presentation on how to plan to maximize the donations for the arena fund from the hockeyville win. This presentation was very informative and gave a lot of great ideas that might be beneficial to CYH as well.
