 - Finalized plans on the dryland room with the City for the new rink construction.
 - Working with the City of Maple Grove on potentially shrinking the TCO ice to 92 feet wide.
 - Reminder on the Codes of Conduct! Make sure if you see something you say something!
- **District 3 Updates- report by Nick Rice**
 - Squirt and U10 teams will be allowed to schedule 2 non-tournament games in a day to accommodate the lower number of district games.
 - Discussions still ongoing for scheduling additional tournaments and if D3 can accommodate moving schedules.
 - D3 teams can schedule games against other D3 teams.
 - D3 refs have been instructed to not start a game without an iPad, paper copies of the gamesheet will not be accepted (unless there is a critical error with the code). If there is no iPad there no game. Home teams should always have a backup iPad in case there is an issue, or they are not supplied by the rink.
 - Associations will be paying for 100% of gamesheet fees next year
 - No more warnings for unrostered coaches or players on Gamesheet, teams will be issued a \$500 fine
 - Approved motion for D3 sponsored goalie coach training, \$3,000 Squirt and U10's to start.
