Call to order at 10:05 am.

Quorum achieved. All Board members were in attendance. Multiple League Members were also present.

Agenda

Commissioner Dan Kissner did a quick review of the agenda.

Introductions

Each of the 2026 PSSA Executive Board Members introduced themselves and their position. Dan announced the 2026 Committee Chairs, highlighting the three open positions: Bylaws, Partnership, and Marketing.

Mission Statement

Dan reviewed the PSSA Mission Statement.

iPride Winter Meetings Update

Dan shared the results of the protests filed and the results. He then shared information about the new iPride bats. Regarding PIP (MAP) submissions, highlighting that the portal is currently open; submissions must be made to the portal and also to PSSA. A question was asked about the iPride submission deadline and it was confirmed to be August. Dan shared the rule changes which include: unlimited courtesies runners for Legends teams; a pitcher rule modification related to location by the pitching rubber; and ejections can occur before, during and after a game. He shared that iPride has granted one additional 2026 and 2027 GSWS berths for C, LC, D, LD, and E divisions. Dan informed the group about the changes to the iPride Board. Dan confirmed that we will continue with "pick-a-stick" this year and that we are using last year's bat. He also confirmed that additional 30 bats have been ordered with delivery scheduled for 2/25.

New for 2026

Dan shared that the Board completed an RFP for an apparel partner and the Board had awarded the contract to KBS Apparel. He shared what KBS offers to the league and teams and why they had been selected. Dan introduced the company representative who was present at the meeting and suggested speaking to her after the meeting if there were any questions. There was a question as to whether the KBS is LGBTQ+ owned and Dan confirmed that it is not but that they support many different LGBTQ+ sports leagues in different cities across the country.

2026 Rules Changes

Dan reviewed the changes to the rules from last season. This includes roster composition, Legends Division structure, bye weeks, regular season awards, iPride GSWS eligibility, EOS protest fees, EOS awards, courtesy runners in Legends, iPride GSWS berths, and 'no-peat' GSWS representation.

iPride Rating Changes

Dan reviewed the threshold adjustments and definition adjustments

2026 Calendar

Dan provided requirements for bye week requests including a limit of one bye per team and total byes per week limited to 2 teams per division (C, D, and E). Dan shared the dates of weekly play and EOS dates. He then shared the dates for league events and skill development clinics. He also shared dates of upcoming iPride tournaments. Dan then shared the important deadlines/dates for: Spring Rosters Due (2/7), Schedule Release (2/22), Board Nominations Open (3/1), Roster Freeze (Wk 2) (3/12), Running Question Removal (Wk 3) (3/22), Player Removal (Wk 6) (4/19), Rating

Submissions (4/20), Ratings Meeting (4/25), and Board Nominations Close (5/3). He then shared information about Extra Innings events. Dan confirmed that ratings requests can be submitted at any time, as long as it is 5 days prior to the Ratings Meeting.

Financial Information

Dan then shared information about our league partners, explaining the important role they play and the importance of supporting them. He then explained the difference between League Fees and Team Dues (where applicable).

Elections & Awards

Dan reviewed the eligibility requirements for Board candidates, the positions up for election in June, and the timeline of dates for nominations and elections. He reviewed the nomination requirements and elections for the following League awards: Hall of Fame, Greg Smith Spirit Award, and Carla Cash & Sam Burge Award.

Director Reports

1. Communications - JC Harsh asked the attendees to send him any communications that are desired to be sent on behalf of teams. He said that they are updating the PSSA website regularly to provide information about upcoming events, including extra innings events. JC highlighted posts on social media for Black History Month, recognizing PSSA players, some who have already passed.
2. Athletics - Robert Wasilchuck informed the attendees that he brought bats to purchase for \$150 and advised anyone interested should see him after the meeting. He is reworking the tracking of all league equipment and there are balls that are currently ordered.
3. Events - Clint Schwalen reminded attendees that for league events, players need to sign-in, even if they have already paid in advance. The team reaching minimum attendance requirements at Uniform Night on 2/21, gets to choose what other Spring Season required league event they want to participate in.
4. Ratings - Matt Malen reconfirmed the ratings information that was provided already in the meeting. He clarified that any running question submissions must be done by the third week of play. Matt informed the attendees that all teams are expected to submit names as representatives for the Ratings Committee. He confirmed that ratings increase can be submitted at any time.
5. Recruitment - Randy Parneszi reported that there are 35 teams registered and 597 players. He noticed that there are two teams who need players to meet the roster requirements. Compared to 2025, there are 4 fewer A Division players, same number of players in B and C, 26 fewer in D, 11 fewer in E, 8 more in Legends D, and the same number of players in Legends C. Randy highlighted that player experience in Spring Season helps to drive repeat players, and he asked for help from the attendees to help create a welcoming and positive atmosphere.
6. Partnership - Travis Eysers reminded everyone how important supporting our sponsors is. He encouraged event attendees to stay at league events. He stated that he is working with the Texas Rangers to plan a League Night.
7. Tournament - Johnathan DeJarnett shared that 32 teams have registered for the Easter Classic. He stated that during the tournament weekend, Friday night will be registration at Woodys and Sunday night will be the awards at the Hidden Door. There is no event planned for Saturday night.
8. Treasurer - Shiloh Shannon confirmed that the 2026 budget was already approved. He informed the attendees that the room deposit checks from 2025 GSWS have been received and if a team has not received their check yet to contact him. There was a question about the impacts to the 2026 GSWS allotted amounts and Shiloh confirmed there would be a small impact due to the number of increased bids.
9. Secretary - Shannon Brown reminded the group that the PSSA Board Meeting dates, agendas, and meeting minutes can all be found on the PSSA website.
10. Assistant Commissioner - Jesse Martinez informed the group that custom scorebooks are available but must be ordered by Tuesday, February 10th. Umpire Clinic is scheduled for 2/21 from 1 pm to 3 pm at McInnish, Scorekeeping Clinics are scheduled for 2/12 and 2/17, and Coach's Meeting is scheduled for next week.

Committee Updates

WINGS Foundation - Shannon Brown reminded the attendees about the purpose of the WING Foundation, where more information can be found, and requested to reach out to him for any questions.
