The meeting was called to order at 1:43 pm by Kelsey Kottek

- I. State financials presented – we have \$43,903.18 in the state account as of April 30th. Pending items would be expenses for State Committee Meeting and Scheduling Meeting.
 - We brought in \$17,840 in admin tax from meets throughout the year.
 - We discussed the upcoming change to the way we bring in money from clubs. Since fewer clubs are hosting meets it was proposed that we adopt a state athlete registration fee to begin for the 2025/2026 season with money due by Dec 31st. This would allow us to bring in enough funds to offer clinics for all levels, supply funds to state meets to offset meet fees, and to give rebates to regional congress attendees.
 - Drew made a motion to edit the amount from \$50 per athlete to \$30 per athlete as a state registration fee beginning fall of 2025 in lieu of the head tax fee on meets. Gabe second the motion; all in favor.
 - The committee discussed all the ways to use the additional funds. Ideas brought up were paying for a L7 All Star Team to attend the National Judges Cup in Anaheim in Jan; pay for equipment for the all dev state meet.; give a stipend to all state meet hosts; pay for summit attendees; give rebates to clubs for sending coaches to regional or national congress.
- II. Financials for State Meets
 - Optional profit was approximately \$3000
 - Xcel profit was \$35,856
 - Compulsory State financials have not been received yet.
- III. Update to Committee Positions – Effective July 1st
 - Northern Compulsory Rep – remains to be Gabe Rice-Erso
 - Southern Compulsory Rep – remains to be Alyssa Lytle
 - Optional Rep – will be a vote between Sara Halverson and LoganMelander
 - Xcel Rep - will be Bailey Coyner

- IV. Championship meet bids:
- Compulsory State combined with Optional State has been awarded to Westside at the Oregon Convention Center
 - Xcel State – has been awarded to Athletic Edge at the Pavillion in Salem, Or.
- V. Lynn reviewed the state process for selecting judges to regionals. The committee then voted on their selection for L8,9,10 and L6,7 and Xcel Regionals based on the rotation recommendations and who submitted the application. Molly, Lynn, and Debbie recused themselves while the committee discussed and voted.
- VI. The committee voted no to doing a leo fundraiser.
- VII. The committee discussed the state process for club of the year and voted to keep as is.
- VIII. Drew gave an update on the Compulsory Summit set for July 12th and 13th at the MAC. There are 160 athletes registered. L9,10 Summit should go live soon with the sanction for people to register.
- IX. Molly discussed the need for demonstrators for the R103 course happening on July 12th at the MAC. Space still available for coaches. There are 12 registered.
- X. Review of State Handbook was held off until the new R and P comes out.

- XI. Standing meeTiffany Quincy gave some news about proposed changes to the Dev program that will come out with the Dev Update in August.
- XII. Next committee meeting will be held virtually in September to vote for judges to our state meets.
