



## Fox Valley Youth Hockey Association (FVYHA)

### COVID-19 Policy Violation Document

We expect that all families will voluntarily comply with the COVID-19 Safety Precautions and Return to Play Guidelines, to protect their skater and everyone around them. If a violation of the policy occurs, the following penalties may apply:

1. If a skater attends a practice or game, when the skater or parent/guardian/adult transporting the skater knows, or should have known, that the skater potentially has COVID, the matter will be immediately forwarded to the FVYHA board for a disciplinary committee to be formed. The skater (and any siblings) will be suspended from practices and games until a hearing determination is made. Penalties can include, but will not be limited to, suspension for a period of time, or the entire season, without a refund.
2. Any other violation of the COVID-19 Safety Precautions and Return to Play Guidelines, or the guidelines of any other hockey association will result in the following penalties:
  - a. For the first violation, a warning will be issued and the individual will have the opportunity to *immediately* remedy the situation (for example if a spectator is not properly wearing a mask that covers their nose and mouth, they can immediately get another, or properly adjust their mask).
  - b. For the second instance, a written warning will be provided, and the individual will be asked to immediately leave the facility.
  - c. For the third instance, the individual will be immediately removed from the current game, written documentation will be provided, and the individual will not be allowed to attend the next game.
  - d. For the fourth instance, the individual will be removed from the current game, will receive written documentation, and the matter will be forwarded to the FVYHA disciplinary committee where the recommendation will be to suspend the individual from all in person attendance for a month.
  - e. For any additional violation, the individual will be removed from the current game, will receive written documentation, and the matter will be forwarded to the FVYHA disciplinary committee where the recommendation will be to suspend the individual from all in person events, for the remainder of the season.

\*Violations are cumulative throughout the season and do not need to be related to the same violation.

\*If law enforcement needs to be contacted to remove an individual from a facility, the matter will be forwarded to the FVYHA Board and the skater associated with the individual will be suspended until a hearing can be held.

\*At any point, if the violation was egregious, it is possible for all steps to be skipped and the matter be forwarded directly to the FVYHA board for a disciplinary committee.
