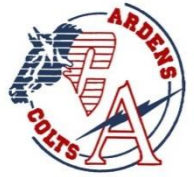

Congratulations on advancing to the SHSAA Provincial Badminton Championships!



Facilities:

- The Swift Current Comprehensive High School is an 8 court facility. We will be using 6 courts for competition, and 2 courts will be set aside for warm-up. The gym has hardwood floors. The gym will be split in half by a curtain with 4 courts on either half of the gym.
- SCCHS has a viewing area ovetop that will have seating for spectators. Please note - spectators are not permitted on the gym floor.
- There will be chairs at the end of each court for coaches to sit while their athletes are playing.
- Dressing rooms are located off the gym. Do not leave your valuables in the dressing rooms as they are open to all teams.

Entrance and Parking:

- We will be using the East gym doors for this event (#1).
- The fire lane (#2) East of the school is a NO PARKING ZONE. We ask that you use the parking lot on the South side of the school (#3).

Athlete and Coach Check-in:

- Upon arrival at the school, please have all athletes and coaches check-in at the table set up inside the East gym doors (#1). Here you will receive your souvenir bags and coaches packages.

Complimentary breakfast:

- There will be a complimentary breakfast in the cafeteria (#4) from 7:30am – 8:30am for all athletes and coaches.
- Menu – Pancakes, scrambled eggs, sausage, muffins, fruit, orange juice, and coffee.

Start time:

- The school will be open by 7:15am.
- Courts will be available for warm-ups at 8:30am.
- There will be opening ceremonies at 9:30am.
- Matches will begin at 10:00am.

Coaches Meeting:

- 9:00am in the lower level (closest to the stage) of the cafeteria (#4).
- Warm-up court procedures and opening ceremonies procedures will be explained at this meeting.

Order of Play:

- As outlined on page 90 of the SHSAA handbook. Two pools of 4 with the top 2 from each pool making the medal rounds.

Rules / Tie-Breaking Procedures:

- Rules are on page 89 of the SHSAA handbook, and tie breaking procedure will be as outlined on page 91 of the SHSAA handbook.

Dress Code:

- All competitors must dress in a predominately white uniform or in a school uniform that reflects the school colors. Doubles teams must be uniform in their dress. Athletes will be asked to remove all jewelry. Goggles are mandatory for all doubles athletes.

Results:

- Results will be posted on the bulletin board on the South wall of the upper gym (behind the spectator seating).

Canteen:

- There will be a canteen in operation throughout the day. It will be located in the cafeteria (#4).

Milk

- SaskMilk has provided 100 containers of free milk for athletes. These will be available at the complimentary breakfast. Any leftovers will be available in the canteen and are on a first come first served bases. Only one milk at a time please.

Clothing:

- The SHSAA boutique will be set up at the school throughout the day.

Photographer:

Medal presentations:

- The medal ceremonies will take place immediately following the final match of the championship.
