

## COACHES AGAINST CANCER SCHOLARSHIP

Each year, the Coaches Against Cancer and the South Dakota High School Coaches Association will award scholarships to qualified and deserving high school graduates. The scholarship is intended to assist qualified graduates to further their education at an accredited institution of higher education.

### Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be or have been a high school student-athlete of an accredited South Dakota high school who has had some medical issues or a family member has had some type of medical issues that may have affected them during their high school career.
2. The scholarship winner must attend an accredited institution of higher education.

### Additional Information:

1. Evidence must be furnished to the Executive Director of the SDHSCA that the applicant has been accepted and will be attending an accredited institution of higher education. This evidence must be certified by the school registrar. When the Executive Director of the SDHSCA has received verification, the scholarship money will be deposited with the institution.
2. There will be no discrimination as to race, color, sex, national origin, physical or mental disability, religion, or otherwise as may be prohibited by federal and state law.
3. Besides other financial aid grants such as scholarships, loans, grants, or work-study, this scholarship cannot exceed the total educational expenses listed above.
4. Any individual will be limited to one scholarship from the SDHSCA. The scholarship will be sent directly to the school the recipient will be attending, with one-half of the aid distributed over two semesters. The recipient has the choice of deferring the scholarship to the following year.
5. If any scholarship is not used during one year, it may be awarded in the following year at the discretion of the SDHSCA Board of Directors.

### Applications:

1. A copy of high school transcripts must accompany the application form.
2. Two letters of recommendation must be obtained. One must be from a community member who knows the applicant well, and one must be from a teacher, coach, or administrator. These must accompany the application form.

Applications must be sent along with all required documents. The application form, transcripts, and letters of recommendation must be mailed together to **Georgia Adolph, 48142 224th Street, Flandreau, SD 57028**, by February 10th. If the applicant is applying for several scholarships from the SDHSCA, each request must include an application, transcripts, and two letters of recommendation.

The final selection will be made at the Board of Directors meeting in March.
