¹ Players who were born on or after September 1, 2000 OR players who were born on or after September 1, 1999 and a high school student in the twelfth (12th) grade or below during some part of the current academic year.

² **Male Only** - Players who were born on or after September 1, 2004 OR players who were born on or after September 1, 2003 (15 years or younger) who shall neither have completed nor are in a grade higher than the eighth (8th) grade during the current academic year **are eligible to play in the 14 & Under division**. This exception is based on the net height difference of 7'4 1/8" to 7'11 5/8" between the 14 and Under Division to the 15 and Under Division.

The Age Definition Policy was most recently revised by the USA Volleyball Board of Directors on January 19, 2002.

The classification cut-off date of September 1 was reviewed by the USAV Junior Assembly and the USA Regional Volleyball Association Assembly prior and during the USAV 2016 Annual Meetings and research justified the continuation of the cut-off date of September 1.

FEES

- G15-Blue Power Team = \$1200
- G15-Black Team = \$700
- G16-Blue Power Team = \$1200
- G17-Blue Power Team = \$1200
- G18-Blue Power Team = \$1200
 - NOTE: Hotel & Travel expenses are NOT included in Fees.



PRACTICE & TOURNAMENTS

- Tournament and Practice times scheduled *after* team selections.
- We try to keep all tournaments within 90 miles of Oshkosh.
- All teams will compete in the Badger Regional Championships!
 - G16, G17, G18 March 16th – 17th
 - G15 teams March 23rd & 24th
- 40 practice dates scheduled. Realistically this will be more like 30 – 35.
- 12 competition dates for G15-G18 Blue Power teams
- 9 competition dates for G15 Black Team



- All teams will compete in the Badger Regional Championships!
 - G16, G17, G18 March 16th – 17th
 - G15 teams March 23rd & 24th
- Power Teams (Blue) will compete in the Badger Region Power League
 - January 19th-20th
 - February 9th – 10th
 - April 13th – 14th

- Practice begin week of November 25th.



TOURNAMENTS

- Scrimmages start in December
- Tournament dates typically start after January 1st.
- Working on warmup Tournament in Mid December.
- Start time: 8 or 8:30am
- Pool play in the morning (Round Robin)
- Playoffs in the afternoon (Bracket Play / Single Elim.)
- Finish around 4pm-5pm depending on how you finish

MAKING THE TEAM

Updating Badger Region Membership

- Once on an Impact VBC team, athlete must purchase a Full Badger Region Membership and select Impact Volleyball as their club prior to their first practice!

Mandatory Parent/Athlete Meeting

- Tuesday November 20th 5pm – 9pm (Webster Auditorium)
 - Review parent/player handbook.
 - Assign Team Parent Rep
 - Pay Dues
 - Fitting for Impact uniforms and gear
 - Meet coaches/players



PAYMENT PLAN BREAKDOWN

- Two/three payment options
- \$1200 payment
 - 1 payment of \$1200
 - 2 payments of \$625
 - Payment plan: down payment of \$400, 4 consecutive payments of \$230
- \$700
 - 1 payment of \$700
 - 2 payments of \$375
- All payments due by the 5th of the month. Any payment received after the 5th will result in \$30 late fee.
- \$50 NSF fee for any bounced check.
