Dancers should be dropped off at Door "E" at Central Middle School Auditorium by 3:30 pm with hair and makeup done and in costume. Parents will take the dancer's jacket & street shoes/boots with them to the auditorium. Our show starts at 4:00 so please be on time. Dancers can be picked up from the stage at the end of the show. **ALL DANCERS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY FOR THE ENTIRE SHOW, EXCEPT TINY TOTS (they can either leave or sit with parent in audience for remainder of the show)** (it only lasts 30-40 minutes). No parents will be allowed in the dressing areas during the show.

We are selling General Admission wristbands for \$5 each or Reserved Seats tickets for \$10 each with \$5 going to our Angel Fund. Wristbands will also be available at the door the night of the pageant (no more reserved seats night of show)

### COSTUME:

- ~ Black tank top or leotard
- ~ White leggings
- ~ Gloves (with fingers – no mittens) & winter hat
- ~ Red star tutu (to be loaned out at the show)
- ~ Tan tights
- ~ Tan slip on jazz shoes (available at 4SDC)

### HAIR:

Low pigtailed to be worn under hat

### MAKEUP:

A little mascara, blush and lipstick is recommended so that the dancers faces are not washed out on stage. Neutral colors along with pink or red lipstick work well for performances.
