

Hi Arapahoe Baseball Families,

Who's ready for the snow to be gone and the crack of the bat to be heard? We again have a ton of talent at every level and are excited to get everyone on the field. As the returning families know too well, the district funds VERY little of our operating budget, so that leaves a financial and voluntary commitment from the families.

The banner sponsorship is one of the great ways to offset your financial commitment. If you see your name on the attached sheet then you need to reach out to the company who already sponsored your player and see if they'd like to renew. You've already done the hard part by getting them to sponsor. Now, just show up at their place of business with the paperwork ALREADY filled out or give them a call or email. You will receive anywhere from \$190 - \$250 toward your player's account per banner sold. This can go toward spring dues, spirit wear and summer ball.

I've attached the current list of banners and who they belong to right now. There is a PLAYERS GRADUATED - AVAIL FOR RENEWAL category that might have already been contacted by someone but I don't have renewals for them.

I've reached out to the sponsors in the CLUB section. That means their total donation goes to the team and I will collect the checks from them.

The next section is CURRENT PLAYERS - NEED TO BRING PAPERWORK FILLED OUT. This means you need to email the paperwork or walk into your banner sponsor's office with it already filled out. Disregard if you have already contacted me. I wanted them all listed to show who is already a sponsor.

If you don't have your name on the chart, go for a new sponsor. Think about businesses that are around AHS or that you use frequently and might see a lot of AHS students/parents use (i.e. dentists, salons, gyms, churches, health clubs, etc.) The first go around is a bit more time consuming because they need to be in contact with me for the banner but, after this year, it'll be just you asking them to renew. The due date is March 15.
