THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS ARE PROHIBITED:

- Violation of any anti-doping policies, protocols or procedures as defined by the International Olympic Committee (IOC; www.usada.org), World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA; www.usada.org) or the United States Olympic Committee (USOC; www.usada.org). Violations of this provision will be adjudicated only by USADA or the proper anti-doping authority, not USA Volleyball (USAV).
- 2. Violation of safe sport rules, policies and procedures promulgated by the U.S. Center for SafeSport (www.safesport.org), as they may be amended from time to time.
- 3. Possession, consumption or distribution of alcohol, tobacco, vaping devices or e-cigarettes if illegal or in violation of USAV or Regional Volleyball Association (RVA) policy.
- 4. USAV policy prohibits the possession, consumption or distribution of alcohol, tobacco, vaping devices or e-cigarettes by anyone registered as a junior volleyball player at the event venue of any USAV/RVA sanctioned junior event.
