# How much does it cost to be a championship level program?

The ATFBC and Coaches are all in — and we mean that. We're not just building a football program, we're building young adults, and that kind of work takes a village of parents who believe what happens on this field matters. SUSD provides the field, helmets, uniforms, and transportation. The ATFBC provides additional support to the program (pre-game meals, events, equipment for the program, capital improvements, etc.)

Every Titans family should budget for these program costs:

- \$50** • **Spring/ Summer Uniform Fee \***  
(Fee included w/ Gold, Platinum and Titanium memberships)
- \$170** • **SUSD Summer Football Fee \***  
\$110 for Session 1 (May 26-June 25) & \$60 for Session 2 (July 6-July 30)
- \$200** • **SUSD Athletic Participation Fee \***  
School district fee that does not stay with the program- \$50 for those on hot lunch & \$25 for those on free lunch
- \$375** • **Titans NAU Summer Camp \***  
Freshman, JV & Varsity- Includes transportation, meals & lodging (Camp fee included w/ Platinum and Titanium memberships)
- \$20+** • **Titans Grille Donations Drive**
- \$815** • **Average minimum per player**

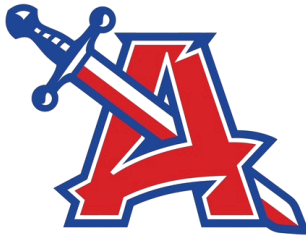
Sophomores: **2 cases** of Gatorade (must be 20oz bottle)

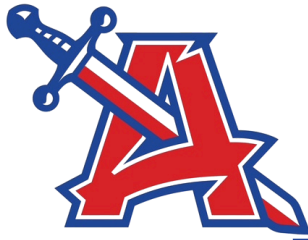
