

2026 PVPGSL Call Ups Rules

1. All call up player requests must initiate from manager to division coordinator for approval. Opposing managers should be communicated with as soon as possible when a borrower player is being used in a game.
 2. In divisions 8U, 10U, 12U, 14U Divisions, in order to 1) avoid a forfeit or 2) be competitive (see 1.1 below), managers are allowed to call up a player if they have at least 7 original members. A team can play with 8 players (for games within PVGSL only).
 - 3 A call up is defined as any player in a lower division.
 - 4 Only one call up player is allowed per team and per game (for games within PVGSL only. Interleague games must field a team of 9 and can call up as many players as needed to get to 9).
 - 5 Call up players can play any position, including pitcher and/or catcher (see 1.2 below), for games within PVGSL only. For Interleague games the call up player must play outfield only.
 - 6 Call up player must bat last in the batting lineup (rules for games within PVGSL AND Interleague)
 - 7 6U is allowed to borrow players within their division and without prior league approval
 - 8 8U calling up a player from 6U is not allowed
 - 9 8U can borrower OF from the opposing team to field a defense. This would not be considered a forfeit.
 - 10 Individual players are eligible to be borrowers multiple times per season, as needed, as long as it does not conflict with the original team schedule. It is recommended, but not required, to give as many eligible players an opportunity
 - 11 Playoffs there is to be no call ups of players. The only exception is to prevent a forfeit. Call ups in playoffs must play OF only and bat last. Division Coordinator is the approver.
 - 12 Division coordinator will consult with the Player Agent, Umpire in Chief, Coordinators in other divisions, E-Board, and managers - if necessary. Division coordinator has final approval on all borrowed players requests
- ****if a call-up cannot be secured by game time and the team has less then 8 required players, the team will forfeit, but the game should still be played with borrowed players within division if possible. Managers should make every effort to play a game****

1.1 - Player agent will approve if a roster is deemed viable based on position eligibility, ie. pitchers and catchers.

1.2 - Division coordinator could apply division specific restrictions on max innings played per position and per game.
