

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR COACHES AND ASSISTANT COACHES Papillion Jr. Titan Football

The Code of Conduct shall govern the actions of coaches and assistant coaches. The Code is intended to provide behavioral guidance and establish clear expectations for all involved. The Code was not conceived to address every possible behavioral circumstance; however, it shall serve as the Organization's standard for behavioral evaluation.

It shall be the obligation of ALL program coaches and assistant coaches, to comply with the terms and provisions of the Code of Conduct. Any person violating the Code shall be subject to administrative action, up to and including termination of his/her privilege to participate in, or attend, any or all Papillion Jr. Titan Football and/or Metro Youth Football League (MYFL) sponsored activities.

Coaches and Assistant Coaches shall remain unconditionally supportive of the Organization's commitment to the ideals of good sportsmanship, team play, honesty, loyalty, courage and respect for authority. In order to adhere to these doctrines, the coaches and assistant coaches agree as follows:

- Coaches will be positive role models.
- Coaches will display and instill in their players the principles of good sportsmanship and team play.
- Coaches will conduct themselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players.
- Coaches will do their best to provide the players a positive & fun experience.
- Coaches will ensure that winning and/or losing teams do so in a manner, which exhibits respect and good sportsmanship.
- Coaches will treat all players, parents, spectators, opposing coaches, league officials and referees with respect.
- Any Physical contact in an aggressive manner, Profanity, Verbal abuse, Obscene gestures will not be tolerated.
- Coaches will provide instruction in a manner that is constructive and supportive.
- Coaches will not ridicule or demean players, other coaches or referees.
- The **Head Coach Only** may initiate discussions with a referee in a civil manner. Under NO Circumstances will a coach yell or storm the field at a referee.
- Coaches will not tolerate behavior that endangers the health or well-being of a child.
- Coaches will comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policy and procedure as established or endorsed by the Papillion Jr. Titan Football Organization and/or Metro Youth Football League (MYFL).
- Coaches will teach the game of football to the best of their ability.
- Coaches will be drug and alcohol free while at any Papillion Jr. Titan Football and/or Metro Youth Football (MYFL) athletic event.
- Coaches will not use any tobacco products on the playing field.
- Coaches acknowledge the need to demonstrate fundamental proficiencies with respect to the game of football and first aid. Consequently, all coaches agree to attend any skill sessions that may be required by the Executive Board and moreover, any first aid courses that may be mandated by the Executive Board.
- **Each team shall be responsible for keeping the spectators orderly and off the playing field and behind the spectator's boundary. Shouting abusive language at**

a player, officials, or spectators is strictly prohibited, and a violation shall result in the enforcement of the MYFL rules. At the immediate time of any incident or physical abuse of an official by any spectator, the officials will meet with the head coaches of both teams in order that every effort is made to identify the assailant.

- **EJECTIONS:** Any player, coach (head or assistant), or spectator who is ejected from a game by the officials or causes a game to be forfeited due to unsportsmanlike conduct will automatically be suspended for the next game (includes playoffs) on the first offence. A second such offence will cause such player, coach, or spectator to be automatically suspended for the remainder of the season (includes playoffs). Any flagrant offence is cause for automatic removal from all MYFL football activities. No reimbursement will be given.
- **EXPULSION:** Physical abuse of any Parent, Game Official or MYFL Commissioner by a player, coach or parent will result in expulsion of the coach / parent and their children from all current and future MYFL activities. No reimbursement will be given.
