

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS--SOUTHWEST MILWAUKEE VBC

(Updated December 4th, 2020)

Southwest procedures

- ❖ No spectators allowed inside the practice facility. Parents should wait in their cars for pickup.
- ❖ Players should not attend practice if exhibiting any symptoms.
- ❖ Masks are required at all time while inside the building.
 - If a player requires a mask break during practice for a health reason, he or she may be excused to do so in a designated area.
- ❖ Players should space out their bags to allow at least 6 feet between players while getting changed.
- ❖ Players should hand sanitize before entering the court area and handling any volleyballs.
- ❖ Players should keep water bottles spread out and use hand sanitizer before handling their water bottles.
- ❖ During practice, players should not high five or hug with other teammates.
- ❖ Players should keep 6 feet between teammates when waiting in line for drills and whenever appropriate.
- ❖ Coaches will sanitize and rotate volleyballs between practices.
- ❖ Coaches will wipe down hard surface areas following practice--tables, chairs, door handles, etc.
- ❖ Bathrooms will be cleaned on a nightly basis.
- ❖ If a player or coach tests positive for COVID-19, Southwest administration will consult health department guidelines to determine the course of action.
