Meeting called to order at 7:30 pm.

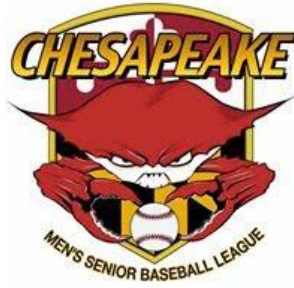
Information from last season: The league had 26 dozen baseballs remaining from 2021 and would work to repair the field groomer provided for Bestgate.

AA County: Joe Cannon would have a drop dead time limit of 3 hours for a 9 inning game and 2.5 hours for a 7 inning which will allow for more games to be played once JC is open. Also the county registration fees would increase, ranging between \$800-1000. JC is slated to be turfed and opened during the 2022 season. Bestgate would also be receiving lights. The county would also be working to improve the conditions at Annapolis as well as attempt to obtain night slots at Riva Park. The league asked if Generals Highway could be locked and secured which would be checked on by the county.

The league can use fields like Lindale and other fields without a permit if permission was obtained by the local organization to use the field.

SmartWavier: MSBL National has provided access to Smart Waiver, a digital waiver system replacing DocuSign.
